LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

The talk of 2002 revolved around the legendary parcels that played host to the Pennsylvania Golf Association championships, in particular, historic Oakmont Country Club, site of the Amateur Championship, and revered Lancaster Country Club, venue for the Open. The two are steeped in tradition and provided magical settings for the cornerstones of the Association calendar.

Congratulations to Nathan Smith of Pinecrest Country Club, who thrilled the galleries at Oakmont with an exhilarating, tournament-sealing birdie on No. 17 for his first Amateur crown and to Terry Hertzog, the pro at Gulph Mills Golf Club, for persevering in a playoff for his second Open title. Also, kudos to all of this year's Pennsylvania Golf Association champions, earning a state title is truly a remarkable accomplishment.

Of course, without the dedication and cooperation of our member clubs to host these events, the Pennsylvania Golf Association would cease to exist. A very special thanks to those clubs and their members for graciously offering their courses and facilities to the Pennsylvania Golf Association and our participants in 2002 and for those who will do so in 2003.

Since its inception in the early 1900s, the Pennsylvania Golf Association has strived to expand and grow the game of golf in the Keystone State. In keeping with that goal, this year the Pennsylvania Golf Association formed an agreement with the Keystone Public Golf Association (KPGA) to allow KPGA member clubs (utilizing the USGA GHIN handicap service) access to Pennsylvania state championships. Our hope is that this agreement will encourage individual players to join a club, either private or public, to obtain a handicap and enjoy the game.

The effects of the KPGA were immediately evident. The Pennsylvania Golf Association saw a substantial increase in participation in the Open, Amateur and Junior.

As we head to 2003, you'll notice the tournament schedule holds some significant changes.

The Senior Amateur Championship, set for Rolling Green Golf Club in Springfield, is adding a Super-Senior Division for those contestants 65 years of age and older. The Junior Championship will head to Penn National Golf Club for the first time in its history, and will be broken into three separate age divisions: 11-and-under, 12-to-14 and 15-to-17. The age requirement for the Middle-Amateur Championship will drop from 30 years of age to 25, mirroring the USGA. Next year's Mid-Am is set for the Longue Vue Club in Verona. And, for the first time in the Association history, the PGA will conduct the George Dressler Pennsylvania State Amateur Public Links Championship. That's set for May 27-28 at Dauphin Highland Golf Club.

Finally, all associations are only as strong as their volunteers are. In 2002, the PGA developed a championship volunteer program to help us better conduct our events in a professional manner. This year about a dozen of you dedicated your time as starters and rules officials, and we thank you for that. In 2003, we're looking to double or even triple that number. 89th Amateur Championship

Oakmont Country Club – Oakmont, Pa.
July 29-31, 2002

Even now, Nathan Smith, months removed from a victorious showing at the 89th Amateur Championship, continues to grapple with the enormity of the achievement. “When I got the trophy and looked at all those great names on it, I figured that realization [of winning] would finally set in,” said Smith in early December, “but it still hasn’t, and I don’t know if it ever will.”

Smith, 24, of Pinecrest Country Club, carded a winning score of 2-over-par at Oakmont Country Club (par 71) to edge his competition by two shots for the Amateur title and earn passage into an elite group of champions. Smith joined the likes of Frank Fuhrer, Buddy Marucci, J. Wood Platt, R. Jay Sigel, and Art Wall, Jr., the 1959 Masters champion, to name a few, that have captured the centerpiece of the Pennsylvania Golf Association calendar.

Smith recorded rounds of 67, 75 and 73 for a 215 total, two strokes better than 1994 Amateur champion John G. Jones, 45, of Oakmont Country Club and three shots clear of Sean Knapp, 40, of St. Jude Golf Club, the 1997 Amateur winner. Junior champion Blaine Peffley placed fourth at 7-over-par and David Brown of St. Clair Country Club and Jon Rusk of Yardley Country Club tied for fifth at 10 over.

“The Pennsylvania Amateur has always been really important to me,” said Smith. “With the quality of play and players in Pennsylvania, to win

that, at Oakmont, is really special.”

As was the way Smith earned the title.

Up two shots over Jones and Knapp on No. 16 (par 3, 232 yards), Smith faced a tricky, uphill sliding putt for par. In the group ahead, Jones and Knapp had birdie opportunities on No. 17 (par 4, 319 yards) to draw closer. With all parties involved able to view the other thanks to Oakmont’s layout, Smith fired the first salvo by stepping up and sinking his par putt. Knapp then slam dunked his 25-foot birdie and Jones tapped in his short under-par chance. Smith’s advantage, three

shots at the start of the day, had now dwindled to one.

“It was electrifying,” said Knapp of the surroundings.

Added Smith, “To watch it unfold was neat.”

With two holes remaining for Smith and one for his closest pursuers, the verdict remained very much in doubt, especially after all three put their ensuing drives in play.

Smith was left with an 100-yard approach shot on No. 17 and Jones and Knapp faced long-iron shots on the brutal 18th hole (par 4, 475 yards). As timing had it, Smith played first and with a 52-degree sand wedge in hand almost holed out. He spun his approach back, just missing the cup, to four feet for an easy birdie.

“The scary thing was that I hadn’t hit that green all week,” said Smith of No. 17. “It seems like it sits on top of everything. It’s so small and the pin

was tucked behind the big mouth [the front bunker]. I felt good about the yardage and the wind was just behind me.”

As the gallery roared, Knapp and Jones didn’t have to see the action to know what happened.

“I knew Nathan had stiffed it and the game was over,” said Knapp. “It sapped the life’s blood out of me.”

Said Jones, “You could tell [by the roar] that he put it close.”

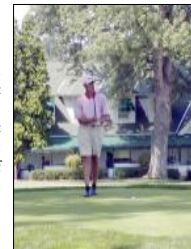
A Jones par and Knapp bogey on No. 18 accounted for their respective overall finishes, second and third. Smith carded a four on the final hole to take the title by two shots.

“[The events that occurred] down the

stretch is what this game's all about," said Smith. "John and Sean played great. Nobody really lost the tournament, I guess I kind of won it."

Up to the Amateur it was a summer of close calls for Smith. He finished second in the West Penn Amateur, the North and South Invitational and the Frank B. Fuhrer, Jr. Invitational.

The Amateur was the fourth straight tournament he found himself in the last day's final pairing.

"It was really frustrating," said Smith of his close calls, "to finally win something like this at Oakmont makes it all worthwhile."

On the first day, tee times determined the better scoring. An afternoon wind made morning pairings advantageous.

With that said, Smith, who started at 7:40 a.m., carded a tournament-best 67.

He recorded five birdies, four en route to a front side 32, and one bogey, that on No. 18, en route to the first-day lead. Chip Lutz of Berkshire Country Club, who teed it up at 8 a.m., ended the day in second after a round-one posting of 68. Knapp carded a 72 and Jones a 73. Both players began after 1 p.m.

"It was so much easier in the morning than in the p.m. on Monday," said

Knapp. "It was really windy and difficult that first day. I really felt if I was going to win I needed to make a move with no wind on Tuesday."

However, the wind never really dissipated and a rain on Monday night watched status quo reign on day two. Five players, including Peffley, netted the best score of the day, a 73.

As for the leaders: Smith shot a 75, Jones a 74 and Knapp a 76.

"I started on the back on day two and Oakmont showed its teeth," said Smith, who captured 15 tournaments while playing for Allegheny College. He graduated in 2001. "The wind was up and the course was playing longer. I shot a 40 on the backside. I knew I had to really play well on the front to stay in it. I shot a 35 to post a 75 and

that was a pretty good score for the afternoon."

Smith recorded two birdies, one bogey and six pars on that final nine.

Which brings us to the third and last round.

Smith leaked a little oil early in the beginning stages on that Wednesday. He made the turn at 2-over-par 38, and bogeyed No. 10 (par 4, 462 yards) and No. 11 (par 4, 382 yards) to give his competitors hope. A birdie on No. 13 (par 3, 185 yards) slowed the spillage, before Smith, working on his M.B.A. at Clarion University, sealed the deal on No. 16 and 17.

"I thought if I put myself into contention enough times, the rest would take care of itself," said Smith.

And it did.

Frank B. Fuhrer Pennsylvania Open

Lancaster Country Club – Lancaster, Pa.
Aug. 12-14, 2002

Terry Hertzog, the pro at Gulph Mills Golf Club, didn't think he had a chance to win the Frank B. Fuhrer Pennsylvania Open Championship when he completed his round a few groups ahead of the leaders in the sweltering heat of Aug. 14 at Lancaster Country Club (par 70, 6,758 yards).

About an hour later, though, after parring No. 18 (par 4, 446 yards) for the second time in that 60-minute span, Hertzog, who served as an assistant at LCC in the early 1990s, found himself standing in front of a small, but supportive group, hoisting the Arnold Palmer Trophy for the second time in three years.

Hertzog, 37, of Flourtown, carded a final-round score of 2-under-par 68 to force a playoff with fellow club professional John D. Mazza of Montour Heights Golf Club. Mazza (72-69-71), who finished his last round with three straight bogeys for a 1-over 71, and Hertzog (76-68-68), both posted 54-hole totals of 2-over-par 212 to force extra holes.

"I didn't think I had a chance [to win]," said Hertzog of his thoughts after finishing his third and final round. "I was thrilled I had a chance for second. To be in the playoff was a gift. It just shows you never know what is going to happen in this game of golf."

The victory was Hertzog's second Frank B. Fuhrer Pennsylvania Open championship. In 2000, at his home course of

Gulph Mills Golf Club, Hertzog made a dramatic rally, birdieing the final three holes for a one-stroke victory.

"It's very special to win it these two times at the two places I did," said Hertzog. "It's a great tournament to win just from the fact it is one of the biggest tournaments in Pennsylvania."

In the playoff, and with all the momentum on his side, Hertzog found the fairway and then the green before two putting from 30 feet for a ho-hum par. Mazza, on the other hand, couldn't keep his round together. He watched his drive trickle into the left-hand rough before flying his second shot long. In doing so, Mazza found the thick grass to the right of the green, failed to get up and down and carded a bogey.

Prior to the playoff, the majority of the afternoon looked like the Mazza Invitational. The 46-year-old Beaver Falls resident showed no signs of weariness from two-plus days of extreme heat and pressure, and approached No. 16 (par 4, 357 yards) holding a commanding three-shot lead.

But after positioning a perfect 5-wood off the tee, he rocketed his wedge shot from 90 yards, albeit into the wind, past the pin. An initial downhill, speedy putt from 30-feet, Mazza three-putted for bogey.

"That was the difference," said Mazza, the 1996 Pennsylvania Open title-

holder of when the championship might have slipped away.

Into the wind again on No. 17 (par 3, 182 yards), Mazza found more trouble when he rocketed his 5-iron into the right greenside bunker. A funky lie produced a long bunker shot and another 1-over score.

"With John still a couple strokes up with a few [holes to] play, I didn't think I had a shot," said Hertzog, who recorded five pars and a birdie in his final six holes en route to a 68.

Hole 18 brought more of the same for Mazza. Holding a one-shot advantage over Hertzog, Mazza crushed a drive down the left-hand side. With a 160 yards to the pin remaining, he ripped a 7-iron.

"Probably the biggest gust of wind we had all day came up," said Mazza of when his ball was in the air.

When it landed, the ball came up just short of the green, some 30 yards

below the flagstick. Mazza decided to use his putter from the closely mowed area in front, but his effort came up 15 feet short. He two putted for bogey.

"There's so much slope in that green," said Mazza. "I just didn't hit it far enough."

For the win, Hertzog collected \$10,000.

Mazza, who almost walked off the course after his first 11 holes of the tournament on Monday - he was 5 over at that time, earned \$6,000 for his second-place finish.

Brian Kelly of the Bucknell GC finished in third place with a 213 total (71-72-70).

Brandon Knaub of the CC of York was the low amateur in the event. The 20-year-old York resident, a junior at the University of Missouri, carded a 217 total (71-74-72) and finished in 11th place.

carded five birdies and five bogeys en route to an even-par 70 in the near 100-degree heat of Lancaster County for a two-day total of 138 and a three-shot advantage over Mazza, Paul A. Oglesby of Merion GC and Rich Steinmetz of Spring Ford CC.

The field of 132 was sliced to the low 40 players and ties after the initial two rounds. The cut line fell at 9-over-par 149 for the 41 players who advanced to the final day.

Aug. 12 - Round 1

Amateur William Smith of Chambersburg Country Club fired a 4-under-par 66 for a two-shot lead over Shuey after the first round.

Smith carded six birdies and two bogeys en route to what would be the lowest round of the tournament.

In all, there were a total of 330 entries for the Pennsylvania Open, with 50 of those players earning exemptions into the field of 132.

9th Middle-Amateur Championship

Williamsport Country Club – Williamsport, Pa.

Mixed in with James Bohn's exhilaration of winning the Middle-Amateur Championship at Williamsport Country Club were tiny twinges of discomfort. On the one side, earning the Mid-Am title provided a resume topper for the 32-year-old dentist and former Penn State University golfer. On the other, the victory came at the expense of Warren Choate, a gentleman of the game who finished as the Mid-Am runner-up for the third straight time.

"I thought about [Warren finishing second] before and after the round, but not during," said Bohn following his, 2&1, victory in the final. "I did have thoughts that this is his home course and all these people following along are pulling for him. I thought that maybe this is his year, but I didn't think about that during the round. You'll lose your competitive edge if you do."

Said Choate on finishing second for a third time, "I wouldn't say I'm snakebitten. This year I didn't feel real confident in my game anyway. I felt fortunate to get into the final."

The verdict, and both players agree, was the result of two strokes of Bohn's putter.

The first round altering shot came on No. 9 (par 4, 408 yards). With the match even, Bohn's 9-iron flew long and just into the first cut of rough behind the green. Choate's ball landed on the putting surface and it looked like the 50-year-old Montoursville

native was going to take a 1-up lead with half a round remaining. Instead, Bohn dropped his 15-foot right to left birdie putt into the jar. Choate two-putted from 10 feet and, unexpectedly, Bohn made the turn 1-up.

A par by Choate on No. 11 (par 4, 358 yards) squared the match, before a perfect chip on No. 13 (par 4, 413 yards) by Bohn helped the Mifflinburg resident recapture a 1-up advantage.

The two matched bogeys on No. 14 (par 4, 429 yards) and pars on No. 15 (par 3, 167 yards) before Bohn sealed his fate on the par 5, 512-yard 16th.

Both reached the green in regulation. Bohn placed his wedge about 12 feet above the hole and Choate faced an uphill 8 footer.

"I was just trying to get it close. From where I was I could easily see three putting," said Bohn. "It was downhill and right to left. It was a squirrely putt. When I hit it I thought it was a real good putt. It hit the back of the hole and dropped in."

Said Choate, "I didn't do anything bad [in the final match], I just couldn't get anything to happen. It came down to two putts. On No. 16, if he doesn't hit the pin, he's eight feet by putting for par." Needing his putt to extend the match, Choate said, "I hit mine where it breaks and it never broke."

The Middle-Amateur Champion-

ship, for players 30 years of age and older, was Bohn's first state title.

Almost as memorable for Bohn, though, was the sportsmanship displayed by Choate early in the final round. An experience he won't soon forget.

"I was stepping off a yardage marker and he said I just want to point out that that yardage marker is known by members not to be accurate. I stepped it off from another marker and there was a 10-yard difference," said Bohn. "He didn't have to do that. It was purely a gentlemanly act."

Ironically, the two also played together in the qualifying rounds earlier in the week. That was the first time Bohn and Choate teed it up in the same group since the Mid-Am semifinals two years ago. Choate stopped Bohn that year.

"I needed to get him back," Bohn said with a smile.

Although Choate may have been disappointed with the final outcome he was fortunate to just make the match play field. He drained a downhill 18-foot birdie putt that broke six inches

for a 74 and a qualifying total of 149. He would later advance to match play in a five-players-for-four-spots playoff.

To reach the final match, Bohn defeated Gary Daniels of Aronimink Golf Club, 3&2, in the semifinals, Rich Morrison of Scotch Valley Country Club, 4&3, in the quarterfinals and Steve Savor of Alcoma Golf Club, 1-up, in the first round. Choate upended James

Douglass of Range End Country Club, 1-up, in the semifinals, Eric McNulty of Williamsport Country Club, 2&1, in the quarterfinals, and Steve Shingledecker of Wanango Country Club, 4&3, in the first round.

Bohn qualified as the third seed for match play with a 142. He posted rounds of 69 and 73.

As previously stated, Choate survived a playoff and was seeded as No. 14 of 16.

Blaine Peffley of Lebanon Country Club turned to his parents and uttered but one word when the Junior Championship at Hershey Golf Club ended. “Finally.” Peffley, burdened by consecutive runner-up finishes in the Junior the prior two years, posted a pair of 72s for a 2-over-par 144 and a one-stroke victory over friend and fellow Lancaster County resident Jarred Texter of Conestoga Country Club.

Texter carded rounds of 71 and 74 for a 3-over-par 145 total. Mark Zbrzezny of Whitmarsh Valley Country Club (76-70-146), Stephen Arnold of Yardley Country Club (74-72-146) and Matt McGinnis of Valley Brook Country Club (71-75-146) all placed third, two shots back.

“It was great feeling to finally win the Junior [Boys] Championship,” said Peffley. “In each of those other years [when I finished second], someone would get hot and beat me. When it was over [this year] my parents and I just looked at each other and said ‘finally.’”

Peffley, 17, of Lebanon, opened the tournament on the back nine of the South Course (par 71, 6,332 yards). He made the turn in 1-under-par 35 and had his score to a tournament best 2-under after a birdie on No. 2 (par 3, 226 yards). Peffley remained at 2 under when disaster struck on the par 5, 470-yard ninth, his 18th hole.

A quirky downhill, dogleg left with a stream splitting the fairway, Peffley recalled standing on the tee and wondering what club to pull.

“I wasn’t sure what to hit because I hadn’t played there in a year and my game had changed,” said Peffley. “I hit a 2-iron. It went a little left and clipped a tree and went out of bounds. The next one, I hit it straight and it rolled into the stream. I was speechless.”

Looking to get to the clubhouse in a hurry, Peffley eventually found the back of the green but was left with a slick, 30-foot downhill bogey chance. Three-putts later, Peffley capped his round with an eight.

“You can’t get too upset, that course is full of surprises,” said Peffley, now a freshman at the University of Arizona. “You expect that kind of stuff to happen.”

Instead of leading after the first day, Peffley

trailed Texter, McGinnis and Greg Franko, Jr. of Duck Hollow Golf Club by a shot. That trio posted first-round scores of 71.

The venue on day two moved to the more difficult East Course (par 71, 6,363 yards), the same site as the yearly Buy.com Tour stop.

Never one to gear down, Peffley stayed aggressive throughout his final 18 holes. He recorded four birdies, three bogies and one double bogey. And as the leaders struggled, Peffley remained focused.

On No. 12 (par 4, 387 yards), Peffley knocked a 3-wood, then gap wedge to five feet for birdie. On No. 13 (par 3, 160 yards), he stiffed a 6-iron to two feet for another birdie. Bogeys on No. 14 (par 5, 481 yards) and No. 17 (par 4, 362 yards) made him even on the back with only No. 18 (par 4, 379 yards) remaining.

A 2-iron off the tee and a pitching wedge from the fairway left him with eight feet for birdie to close the round.

"I was reading [the putt] and I wasn't sure about the read. I got up over it and went through my routine and then I backed off," said Peffley. "I just picked out a spot and rammed it in. I thought I needed a birdie on No. 18."

As it turned out he did.

Texter, a group behind Peffley, also posted a three on the final hole.

"I know [Texter's] game," said

Peffley. "I knew he was the one to beat."

Added Texter, 17, a junior at Penn Manor High School, "I actually thought he was three or four strokes ahead of me. The two previous years Blaine's finished second and I've finished third so at least this year we each moved up a spot."

Peffley's been knocking on the Junior title door for the past couple of seasons.

Last year, Peffley found himself tied with Shawn Hall at 69 after the first day but watched his opponent card a 66 compared to his 73 in the final round.

Two years ago, Nathan Shevchik of Whitford Country Club edged Peffley by a stroke. Peffley posted a final-round score of 2-under-par 69 to just miss. Shevchik carded an even-par 71.

When Peffley was 13 years old, he placed fourth.

"[Winning this has] been a goal of mine ever since I started playing in it," said Peffley.

Herb Gordon of Doylestown Country Club recalls the particulars of May 21 and the Senior Amateur Championship, but he can't explain them. And when the 63-year-old tried detailing the happenings of that frigid spring day in Northwestern Pennsylvania, the soft-spoken Gordon could only repeatedly recite, "I guess it was my day."

In reality, Gordon, humble to a fault when it comes to publicizing his golfing ability, doesn't have to say a word. Spurred on by a red-hot putter in bitter cold conditions, Gordon's actions spoke volumes as he led from start to finish in capturing the 43rd Senior Amateur Championship (55 years of age and older) at New Castle Country Club (par 72, 6,349 yards).

Gordon's final-round score of 78 for a 153 total (9 over) proved three shots better than his closest challenger Bill Baloh of Hannastown Golf Club, the 1999 Senior champion, who shot a 156 (77-79). Carl Everett of Merion Golf Club placed third with 157 (79-78) and Peter Smith of the Kahkwa Club finished fourth with 158 (79-79). Edward Gregorczyk of Glenmaura National Golf Club, Robert Marek of Carlisle Country Club and Richard Smith of Philadelphia Country Club all tied for fifth at 160.

"There are a lot of guys that are a lot better players than I," said the modest Gordon, "but I just tried to hang in there and play each hole as it came up. I think I've learned to play better in [high-pressured] events. You have to be smart and not get yourself in too much trouble. Rarely do opponents play well all the time so I try not to make too many big mistakes. I don't gamble [on shots] either because that never works. I really think the game when I'm out there."

Taking a conservative approach on this 1923 A.W. Tillinghast design with its demanding, undulating greens proved his best bet. Remarkably, Gordon recorded no three putts on either day.

With the flat stick running on hot, he made a trio of clutch eight-foot par putts on the final three holes in addition to two other round alternating rolls on the back nine.

"I played a practice round before the start of the tournament and I saw that you couldn't charge putts because the greens were like lightning," said Gordon. "If anything, you had to leave [your putts] short and not be as aggressive."

Gordon's good fortune and the golf tournament revolved around two holes and a couple of putts on the back nine of the second day.

On No. 11 (par 4, 341 yards), a short par 4 with a severe green that slopes right to left, Gordon had a birdie chance from under the right side of the pin when his putt caught a ridge and ended 50 feet away in the left fringe.

Baloh, meanwhile, was left with a 4-footer, albeit above the hole, for a par. Gordon lagged his next putt up to 15 feet, and still away, watched as his next attempt missed the hole again. Seemingly appearing to have eyes, though, Gordon's ball rolled into the back of the cup for a bogey five.

Baloh, who trailed Gordon by three shots at this point, looked in prime position to capitalize: but couldn't. He missed his par opportunity and when it was all said and done finally carded an unthinkable double-bogey six.

"Instead of picking up two strokes," said Baloh. "I lost one."

On No. 15, a short par 5 (472 yards), Baloh just missed the green in two. Gordon was left with about a 100-yard wedge shot for his third and dropped it to four feet. He made the birdie. Baloh, meanwhile, faced a difficult chip over a knob in the green and watched as it rolled off the back of the putting surface. He failed to get up and down and recorded a bogey.

"If you put those two holes together that was the tournament," said Baloh, 58, of Herminie, Pa., who later in the

summer would advance into the U.S. Senior Amateur semifinals. "He had a real hot putter all week. Sometimes I believe in destiny. On No. 2, he put his ball into the bunker and I had a 12-foot birdie putt left. He blasted out to the far side of the green into the fringe and then knocked it in for par. I two putted and I could see right then that his putter was going to be the club today."

Three straight pars by Gordon to finish, all testy eight-footers, left the auto parts businessman the 2002 champion.

"It might have changed the whole tournament if I missed any of those [late] par putts," said Gordon, who

posted an opening-round 75 and led by two strokes after the first day. "It was just my day."

Gordon finished third in the 2001 Senior Amateur Championship, his top showing prior to this spring. He remembers having a chance for the title that year when his game fell apart on No. 16. This season Gordon relied on his strong finish to earn the crown.

"It's nice to get some recognition from some of the better players in the area," said Gordon, a former Temple University baseball player. "This was definitely my most exciting athletic accomplishment."

There's a certain comfort level associated with being familiar with your surroundings.

Chris Lilly and Scott Micklewright of Blue Ridge Country Club and their final round in the 13th annual Better-Ball Championship can attest to that.

Drawing upon the coziness and advantages of their home course (par 72, 6,740 yards), Lilly and Micklewright recorded an 8-under-par 64 on the final day for a two-round total of 13-under-par 131 and a two-shot victory over Michael Domenick of Phoenixville Country Club and John O'Sullivan of Chester Valley Golf Club (133). Brian Groff and John Sweeney of Conestoga Country Club placed third with a 10-under-par 134. Three other teams tied for fourth at 9 under.

"Everyone [at Blue Ridge] knew we were playing in the tournament, so

there was a little extra pressure," said Lilly. "It was also of comfort to know that no matter where you hit the ball on the course, you knew exactly what you were going to face."

Added Micklewright, "[During the summer] we play that course everyday together. No matter where we were on the green, we knew which way the putt broke and what the speed of the green was."

Heading into the second and final round of the two-day event, Lilly and Micklewright trailed the leaders by a shot. The duos of William Smith of Chambersburg Country Club and Jack Fugal of Hidden Valley Golf Course and Michael McDermott and Paul Shevlin, Jr. of Lanerch Country Club each posted opening-round 66s.

Lilly, 22, of Harrisburg, and Micklewright, 20, also of Harrisburg, and the son of Blue Ridge club professional Peter A. Micklewright, carded a first-round, 5-under-par 67 with seven birdies and two bogeys.

"We left some shots out there," said Lilly of the opening round. "We recorded no birdies on the two par fives on the back.

"We knew we were going to have to go low to win it, but we didn't think we had to go *that* low."

That low equated to a 64.

The twosome birdied No. 3 (par 4, 340 yards), No. 4 (par 4, 365 yards) and No. 5 (par 5, 500 yards) for the second straight day to open their final round. A clutch 6-foot par saving putt on No. 6 (par 3, 215 yards) by Lilly kept the momentum, and his birdie on No. 8 (par 4, 425 yards) added to it. The pair made the turn in 32.

Birdies by Micklewright on No. 10 (par 4, 420 yards) and No. 12 (par 4, 375 yards) had the twosome thinking title when they approached the scoreboard on No. 16 and saw their lead stood at only one stroke over Domenick and O'Sullivan.

"We knew no one around us was

within a couple of shots but we were a little surprised when we saw the scoreboard and a group ahead us was only one shot back with 17 and 18 to play," said Micklewright, a sophomore on the Millersville University golf team. "We knew if we parred 16, birdied 17 and parred 18, things would be fine."

And that's exactly what the two did, well almost.

A 6-foot par putt by Micklewright on No. 16 (par 3, 170 yards) kept the pair in front.

Lilly bombed his drive on No. 17 (par 5, 470 yards), leaving 160 yards to the pin. A 9-iron approach and two putts later, Micklewright, who also was in prime birdie range, and Lilly reclaimed the lead.

For good measure, Lilly dropped his 7-iron from 170 yards on No. 18 (par 4, 425 yards) to eight feet. He made the putt for birdie.

"I knew we were good enough," said Lilly, a junior on the James Madison University golf squad. "You always say you can win any tournament, but until you do it, it's a different feeling. We were the talk of the club for awhile."

James Haynie's 10-foot par saving putt on the 36th and final hole preserved the Senior Better-Ball Championship title (55 years of age and older) for himself and partner A. Kent Weymouth, Jr.

The Lu Lu Country Club duo posted rounds of 66 and 73 over the event's two days for a 139 total (5 over) and a one-shot victory over Carl Everett of Merion Golf Club and Mike Rose of Philmont Country Club. Four teams tied for third, two shots backs.

"It was my first Senior [state] victory, so it meant a lot," said Haynie, 56, of North Wales. "It was a quality field we beat."

Added Weymouth, 60, of Wayne, "I play in a lot of the Pennsylvania Golf

Association and Golf Association of Philadelphia events and you wonder sometimes if you are ever going to get a chance at winning one. It's nice we did."

After posting an impressive 6-under-par 66 (par 72, 6,520 yards) in the first round for a three-shot lead, Haynie and Weymouth's apparent smooth sailing found rocky going on day two.

A bogey on No. 3 (par 4, 335 yards) and a double on No. 4 (par 4, 355 yards) brought the leaders back to the pack.

A birdie by Haynie on the par 3 6th hole (195 yards) stemmed the tide for a bit and the two made the turn with a one-shot advantage.

Birdies on No. 10 (par 4, 395 yards), No. 12 (par 4, 365 yards) and

No. 14 (par 5, 490 yards) with only a bogey on No. 13 (par 3, 180 yards) increased their advantage to two shots with four holes remaining.

However, a three-putt bogey on No. 16 (par 3, 160 yards) chopped that lead to one with two holes left and the tension mounted.

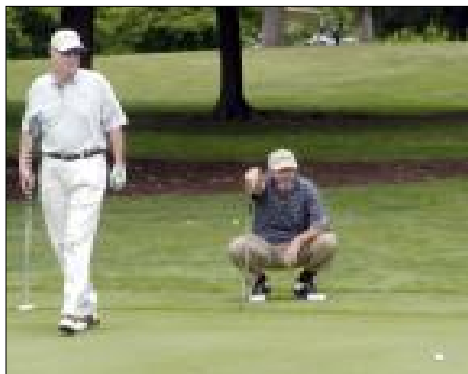
Haynie missed a four-foot birdie putt on No. 17 (par 4, 470 yards) that would have, in reality, sealed the title, meaning the two needed a par on the tight, tree-lined 18th (par 4, 410 yards) for the win.

With that said, Haynie's approach shot after a perfect drive came up just short of the green. Weymouth's drive found trouble, and he struggled to get back into the hole.

The pin placement on No. 18 was just over a crest. Haynie chipped up over the ridge but watched as the ball came to a stop 10 feet past the cup.

Knowing he needed a par to avoid a playoff, Haynie, who admits putting isn't one of his game's strongest components, calmly rolled in his par.

"I was between clubs in the fairway and when I hit my 8-iron, a little gust of wind came up and the ball landed just short of the green," said Haynie. "I felt very fortunate to make the putt."

10th Senior Tournament

Philmont Country Club (North/South) – Huntingdon Valley, Pa.
Sept. 30 & Oct. 1, 2002

Mike Rose of Philmont Country Club readily admits the disappointment of his first year as a senior competitor. The 55-year-old Rose entered 2002 with stellar credentials and lofty expectations but struggled to contend in elder events.

Rose said he learned quickly that “these old guys can play.”

At the year-end Senior Tournament, Rose proved his game’s not too shabby either.

Heartened by the familiarity of his home course, Rose posted a 3-over-par 143 total to blitz the 10th annual Senior Tournament field by six shots at his home course of Philmont Country Club (North/South). The resident of Huntingdon Valley posted rounds of 70 (on the South Course) and 73 (on the North Course) over two days to outdistance second-place finisher Phil Saylor of Sunnehanna Country Club (68-81–149).

Herbert Gordon of Doylestown Country Club, the 2002 state Senior Amateur Champion, and Russell Oakes of Yardley Country Club tied for third at 152. Sharing fifth was Fran Villella of DuBois Country Club and Charlie Stringfellow of Carlisle Country Club with 153 totals.

“Home course advantage,” said Rose of the reason for his margin of victory. “It’s second nature for me to play [at Philmont]. I tee it in the same spot and hit it to the same spot every time. The course favors a left to right player and I still play mostly that way. It’s a shot maker’s course and with the local knowledge of the greens ... “

Rose, publisher of the *Delaware Valley Golfer’s Guide*, has been a member at Philmont Country Club for 42 years and is a veteran of tournament golf. His success in events on his home track is well documented.

Beginning in 1980, Rose captured six consecutive Golf Association of Philadelphia Tournament of Champions titles at Philmont. Those days, the following year’s tournament was held at the winner’s home course. After Rose’s

string, that changed. He’s also a 10-time Philmont Country Club champion.

In the first round of the Senior Tournament, Saylor posted a 68 on the North Course, while Rose shot a 70 on the South.

“The South is generally easier, but it is very quirky,” said Rose. “I thought if I shot a 72 or 73 [on the North in the final round], I might be able to get close. As it turns out, the greens [on the South Course] got to [Saylor]. After a couple of three putts at the turn, he lost it on the back.”

As Saylor struggled with the flat stick on the South, Rose paired up birdies and bogeys on the North. At three separate times during his second round, Rose birdied a hole only to follow with a bogey on the next.

“I thought if I got through the first five holes in 1-over par or better I’d be in good shape,” said Rose.

Rose actually was 2 over on his final round after seven holes when he started with the peaks and valleys.

He dropped a wedge to 10 feet on No. 8 (par 3, 122 yards) for birdie only to three putt No. 9 (par 5, 565 yards).

A sand wedge from the fairway on No. 10 (par 4, 315 yards) to three feet resulted in another under par score before a bogey on the long par 3, 11th hole (210 yards) cancelled that birdie out. Bogeys on No. 13 (par 4, 317 yards) and No. 14 (par 4, 429 yards)

preceded a birdie on No. 16 (par 4, 439 yards). However, as his form that day dictated, he pulled a 6-iron on No. 17 (par 3, 163 yards) that yielded a 1-over score.

The ups and downs left Rose wondering how he stood heading to the final hole.

Tempted to walk to the scoreboard to view the leaders’ totals, Rose resisted. Instead he closed the round in fashion with a 20-foot uphill birdie on No. 18 (par 4, 336 yards).

“It was a putt I’ve had a 100 times,” said Rose. “It was uphill, inside left. It was just a matter of getting it on line.”

Meanwhile, Saylor struggled to get his round home. He carded two bogeys, two double bogeys and a triple bogey on the back en route to an inward 43 and a second-round score of 81.

Net Division

In the Net Division, William Taylor of The Springhaven Club captured his second consecutive Senior Tournament title. The 22 handicap posted net rounds of 68 and 66 for a 134 total, two shots clear of the field.

Lyle Brion of Corey Creek Golf Club, an 11 handicap, finished second with a 136 net, (rounds of 70-66).

Taylor, 64, competed in the Class D Division (60-64 years of age).

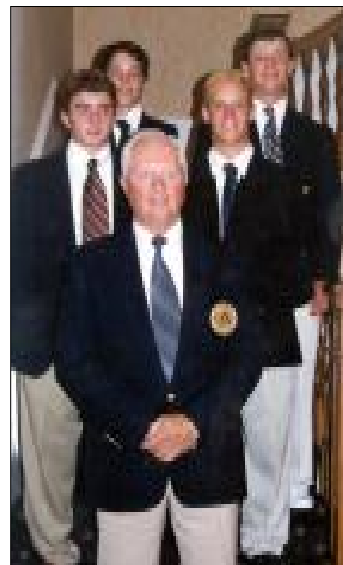
