The Pennsylvania Golf Association's 2003 season was one of firsts. The Association took its championship to new venues across the Commonwealth, crowned first-time Pennsylvania State Champions, administered the inaugural Williams C. Fownes, Jr., Amateur Player of the Year Award and the Association's Williamson Cup team earned the organization's first victory in that prestigious junior event. This year was also the first time the Pennsylvania Golf Association conducted the George Dressler Pennsylvania State Amateur Public Links Championship with Dauphin Highlands Golf Course in Harrisburg serving as the host. And in its initial try, the Association received great feedback on the added age divisions in the Junior and Senior Amateur Championships.

Congratulations to Brandon Knaub of the Country Club of York on his wire-to-wire victory in the 90<sup>th</sup> Pennsylvania Amateur Championship at the Country Club of Scranton. Knaub's track record speaks for itself. He

was the 1998 State Junior Champion and the Low Amateur in the 2001 Open.

For the second year in a row, the Open Championship was decided in a playoff, with the eventual champion Steven Wheatcroft, of Washington, Pa., recording a birdie on the 18th at Stonewall to force an extra hole.

The highlight of the 2003 season was the team of Garrett Basalyga, Scott Deakins, Brandon Detweiler and Matthew Mattare earning Pennsylvania's first victory in the A. Fred Williamson Cup Matches at the Royal Montreal Golf Club - in only the Association's third try. Basalyga and Detweiler, in fact, finished one-two in the individual standings.

Of course, without the dedication and cooperation of our member clubs to host the events, competitive amateur golf at the state level would cease to exist. A very special thanks to those clubs and their memberships, professional staffs and ground crews for graciously offering their courses and facilities to the Pennsylvania Golf Association and our participants in 2003 and for those who will do so in 2004. I would also like to recognize the staff, committee members and volunteers for all of their efforts during the past year.

A special congratulations to Nathan Smith of Pinecrest Country Club on being crowned the Pennsylvania Golf Association's inaugural William C. Fownes, Jr., Amateur Player of the Year. Smith concluded a great year with a victory in the U.S. Middle-Amateur Championship at Wilmington Country Club in Greenville, Del.

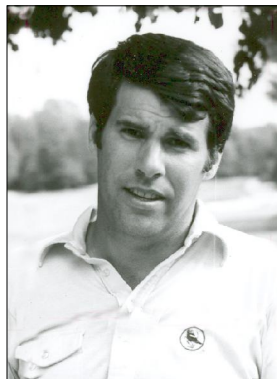
The 2004 season is packed with some of the Commonwealth's finest venues and we will be introducing the R. Jay Sigel Pennsylvania State Match Play Championship in June.

# R. Jay Sigel Match Play Championship

**R.** Jay Sigel, arguably, is the top amateur golfer ever born and raised in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. In 2004, the Pennsylvania Golf Association will honor Sigel's name and legacy with a new championship that will match the best of the best.

The Pennsylvania Golf Association, in keeping true to its mission statement of promoting the game of golf in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, will add the R. Jay Sigel Match Play Championship to its rotation this summer.

The event will match 32 of the top amateurs from the state. The field will consist of the top 31 players on the William C. Fownes, Jr., Amateur Player of the Year standings – with the caveat that they competed in at least one Pennsylvania Golf Association event the year

prior – and the current club champion of the host site. It is set for June 7-9 at Aronimink Golf Club, Sigel's home course of many years.

Sigel's amateur credentials are remarkable and span more than three decades. He was a two-time U.S. Amateur Champion, a three-time U.S. Middle-Amateur Champion and a representative of the U.S. on the Walker Cup team nine times, including twice as captain in 1983 and 1985. He was an 11-time Pennsylvania Amateur Champion, a two-time Pennsylvania State Open Champion and a two-time Pennsylvania Junior Champion. His first Pennsylvania Golf Association championship was the 1960 Junior and his final was the 1990 Open. He turned professional and joined the then Senior PGA Tour in 1994.

"We believe this tournament will become one of the premier amateur golf events in Pennsylvania," said Frank Rutan, IV, the President-elect of the Pennsylvania Golf Association. "The limited field will be made up of the most accomplished golfers in the state and this will be our only match play event. We are proud to honor Jay Sigel for all he has done in and for the game."

**C**LARKS SUMMIT, Pa.-A few early birdies and steady all-around play helped Brandon Knaub of the CC of York eliminate any drama from the final round of the 90<sup>th</sup> Amateur Championship at The Country Club of Scranton (Old Course, par 72, 6,780 yards).

Knaub finished at 12-under-par for the 54 holes (67-68-69) en route to his first Amateur title, four shots clear of the field.

James Bohn of Bucknell GC, the 2002 state Middle-Amateur champion, finished in second at 8-under-par and Clint Deibert of Doylestown CC placed third at 7-under-par.

Knaub's performance set a 54-hole scoring record. His 204 was five shots lower than any other 54-hole total for an Amateur Championship.

On that final day of the Amateur at Scranton, Knaub made it clear early that this was his Amateur title to win or lose.

An aggressive 8-iron on No. 3 (par 3, 182 yards) dropped to six feet. His birdie made him 10 under.

On No. 4 (par 5, 514 yards), Knaub carded another red digit, this time knocking a wedge to eight feet left of the hole before brandishing his smooth putting stroke.

Bogeys on No. 5 (par 3, 204 yards) and No. 7 (par 4, 399 yards) stymied his momentum a tad, but a tap-in birdie on No. 8 (par 4, 323 yards) eliminated any doubt.

A 40-foot birdie bomb on No. 11 (par 3, 161 yards) from the left side of the green started the coronation.

"That's a nice way to start a round," said Knaub of his early birdies. "Honestly, I didn't look at the scoreboard all day. I just tried to play the golf course."

Bohn, who started at 4-under-par, five back of Knaub, made an early surge with three birdies in his first five holes – at No. 2 (par 4, 405 yards), No. 4 (par 5, 514 yards)

"This means a lot," said Knaub, who posted a final round 3-under-par 69. "I was real confident coming in with my game and my swing." And everything worked out - in record fashion.

and No. 5 (par 3, 204 yards).

"I started to get pretty nervous then because I've never really been in that position," said Bohn, 33, of Lewisburg. "My target score for the day was still 4 or 5 under and to see what happened. Realistically, I needed help. I mean he had to shoot a few over par and that wasn't going to happen."

Bohn made the turn at 3-under-par 32 after a bogey and another birdie, but posted only a 1-under-par 36 on the back nine for a 68.

This was Bohn's highest finish since the Amateur last visited the CC of Scranton in 1997. That year he finished fourth.

Deibert, 21, of Doylestown, eagled No. 12 (par 5, 483 yards) after lofting a 5-iron in close and birdied No. 13 (par 4, 382 yards) and No. 18 (par 5, 482 yards) to get to 7-under-par.

"I'm not surprised [Brandon Knaub] ran away with it, he's a great player," said Deibert. "I was playing for second. He wasn't going to fold."

John Robinson of Commonwealth National GC and Billy Stewart of Llanerch CC, who both started the day at 6-under-par and in a tie for second, dropped down the leaderboard.

Robinson, 45, of North Wales, triple bogeyed the second hole to eliminate his chances. He finished 17<sup>th</sup>. Stewart, 19, of Devon, failed to get out of the greenside bunker on No. 6 and recorded a double bogey. He placed 10<sup>th</sup>.

# Frank B. Fuhrer Pennsylvania Open

Stonewall – Elverson, Pa.  
Aug. 11-13, 2003

**E**LVERSON, Pa.-Steven Wheatcroft, a mini-tour pro from Washington, Pa., parred the first playoff hole to edge Kevin Shields, an assistant pro from Nemacolin Woodlands Resort, to take the Frank B. Fuhrer Pennsylvania Open Championship at Stonewall (par 70, 6,699 yards).

Wheatcroft carded a birdie on his final hole (No. 18, par 4, 451 yards) of regulation to force a tie with Shields before earning the victory in the playoff with a par. Both players finished at even-par 210 for the three rounds.

"I knew I had to hit something close the first time," said Wheatcroft, 25, a regular on the Gateway Tour. "I figured if I made a birdie and he made a par I'd force a playoff. Then he made the best up and down [for par] I've ever seen considering all the pressure and circumstances."

On 18 the first time around, Wheatcroft, playing before Shields, knocked a 7-iron from 174 yards to four feet to put the pressure squarely on his competitor. Shields, who blocked his drive into the right rough, but still with a decent lie, blasted his second shot over the brick wall guarding the left of the green. A miraculous up and down by Shields saved par and sent the Open into a playoff for the second consecutive year.

In the playoff, Shields again blocked his drive right, but this time into the thick

fescue.

Wheatcroft placed his drive in almost the identical spot as he did in regulation.

Shields could only punch out and Wheatcroft dropped his 7-iron, this time, to about 15 feet left of the flag. Shields failed to get up and down and Wheatcroft netted a par for the win.

"I've been fighting [my swing] all year long," said Shields, 31, of Pittsburgh. "It's an under plane puff fade. Once I hit it once, it's like a disease."

Shields controlled the Pennsylvania Open for the majority of the day.

He built a five-shot advantage after nine holes, playing the front side in 4-under-par 31. He birdied No. 1 (par 5, 511 yards), No. 2 (par 4, 389 yards), No. 4 (par 4, 370 yards) and the difficult eighth (par 4, 430 yards).

Wheatcroft, who was the second-

round leader, a shot clear of the field at 2-under-par entering day three, struggled. He bogeyed No. 2 and No. 3 (par 5, 564 yards).

A four-putt on No. 8 (par 4, 430 yards), in which he missed a six-inch bogey effort and finished with a double, seemed to end any chance at the title.

"I lined up and got set and hit it square right," said Wheatcroft of the short bogey miss. "I thought I was out of it after that."

On No. 9 (par 3, 219 yards), momentum started to swing, though. Wheatcroft chipped in from the right greenside bunker, about 60 feet away, for birdie.

On No. 10 (par 4, 395 yards), an errant drive to the right started Shields downfall. He finished with a bogey.

Another black digit on No. 13 (par

4, 455 yards) for Shields, a missed five footer from the left side of the hole, resulted in another bogey.

On No. 16 (par 4, 463 yards), Shields, in effect lost the Open Championship. He blasted his drive over a wall on the right side of the fairway into a wooded area. A lost ball and a five with the provisional officially carded Shields a triple-bogey seven.

"I was thinking good all day," said Shields, "but I was waiting for the [fade] shot to come up."

For the victory, Wheatcroft earned \$10,000. Shields netted \$6,000 for second place.

Chris Lange of Overbrook GC was the low amateur, finishing in a tie for fourth at 3-over-par 213.

# 10<sup>th</sup> Middle-Amateur Championship

Longue Vue Club – Verona, Pa.  
Sept. 8-11, 2003

Lynn Kilduff made a mental adjustment in his approach to match play, mixed it with some sensational shot making and used a tinge of good fortune to take the 10<sup>th</sup> Middle-Amateur Championship title at the Longue Vue Club.

Kilduff, a member of Huntsville GC, defeated Curt Coulter of Oakmont CC, 1-up, to cap a four-day span in which he displayed remarkable skill and resolve.

"Any time you win a state championship is special," said Kilduff, 25, of Dallas. "I think it's particularly special because I don't think there is much of a drop off from the [straight] amateurs to the middle-amateurs. It's a great field. If you look at the player of the year standings, the top 10 are all mid-ams."

Kilduff and Coulter, playing in their first Middle-Amateur Championship, added a memorable chapter to the event's history books.

The match entered No. 7 (par 4, 323 yards) All Square when Kilduff forged ahead and took three of the next four holes for a 3-up advantage. A par on No. 7, an eagle on No. 8 (par 5, 507 yards), courtesy of a 25-foot chip-in from the rough, and another par on No. 10 (par 3, 171 yards) put Kilduff in an enviable position with eight holes to play.

The eagle was actually Kilduff's third chip-in in his first eight holes. He knocked the ball in from the fringe on No. 2 (par 4, 390 yards) with a putter for a par and a halve, did the same on No. 5 (par 3, 196 yards) for a birdie from 35 feet behind the hole and followed those two up with that 25-foot run out with a sand wedge from the rough on No. 8.

"Things were obviously going well," said Kilduff. "I started to feel a little overconfident on No. 11, though, and started getting away from my game plan. Instead of playing aggressive, as I did the entire tournament, I started playing a prevent type of deal and got conservative."

That philosophical alteration from the prior three days almost proved lethal.

Coulter, the obvious recipient of some hard luck courtesy of Kilduff's remarkable shot making, started to climb back into the match. The 37-year-old resident of Oakmont took the 11<sup>th</sup> (par 4, 400 yards) with a par and the 12<sup>th</sup> with its difficult putting green on a bogey.

Coulter finally evened the match on No. 15 (par 5, 540 yards) with a five.

On the 16<sup>th</sup> (par 3, 200 yards), Kilduff's helter-skelter game continued. This time he missed the green to the right with Coulter staring at a 12-footer for birdie. Kilduff, from a bad lie, said he "just wanted to get the ball on the green" and did but added another touch of magic by sinking a 14-foot left to right, full cup breaker for the par.

Coulter's birdie opportunity slid by. "I was thinking he was going to make bogey," said Coulter.

On No. 17 (par 4, 434 yards)

Kilduff wrestled the lead back for good, again, with some uncanny shot making.

Kilduff blasted his drive into the deep right rough and was left with 151 yards to the flag. He trapped his 8-iron and landed it in a tricky spot, about 10 feet below the hole.

Sean Knapp, a top amateur on the national stage from Western Pennsylvania and a member at Longue Vue Club, was caddying for Coulter after falling in the first round of match play. Knapp told Coulter that Kilduff's birdie chance was a "really hard putt." Kilduff knew it too, but jarred the putt, which bent two cups left to right, for a 1-up edge.

Kilduff's good fortune continued on No. 18 (par 4, 471 yards) when his drive found the base of a tree and kicked 15 yards into the fairway. A smooth 7-iron and three putts later gave Kilduff the title.

"With the quality of the field that I knew was going to be there, I'm happy to finish second," said Coulter.

Kilduff advanced to the final with a 3&2, victory over Joe O'Donnell of the Longue Vue Club in the semifinals. In his first two matches, Kilduff defeated Tom Amendola of the Kahkwa Club in the quarterfinals and survived extra

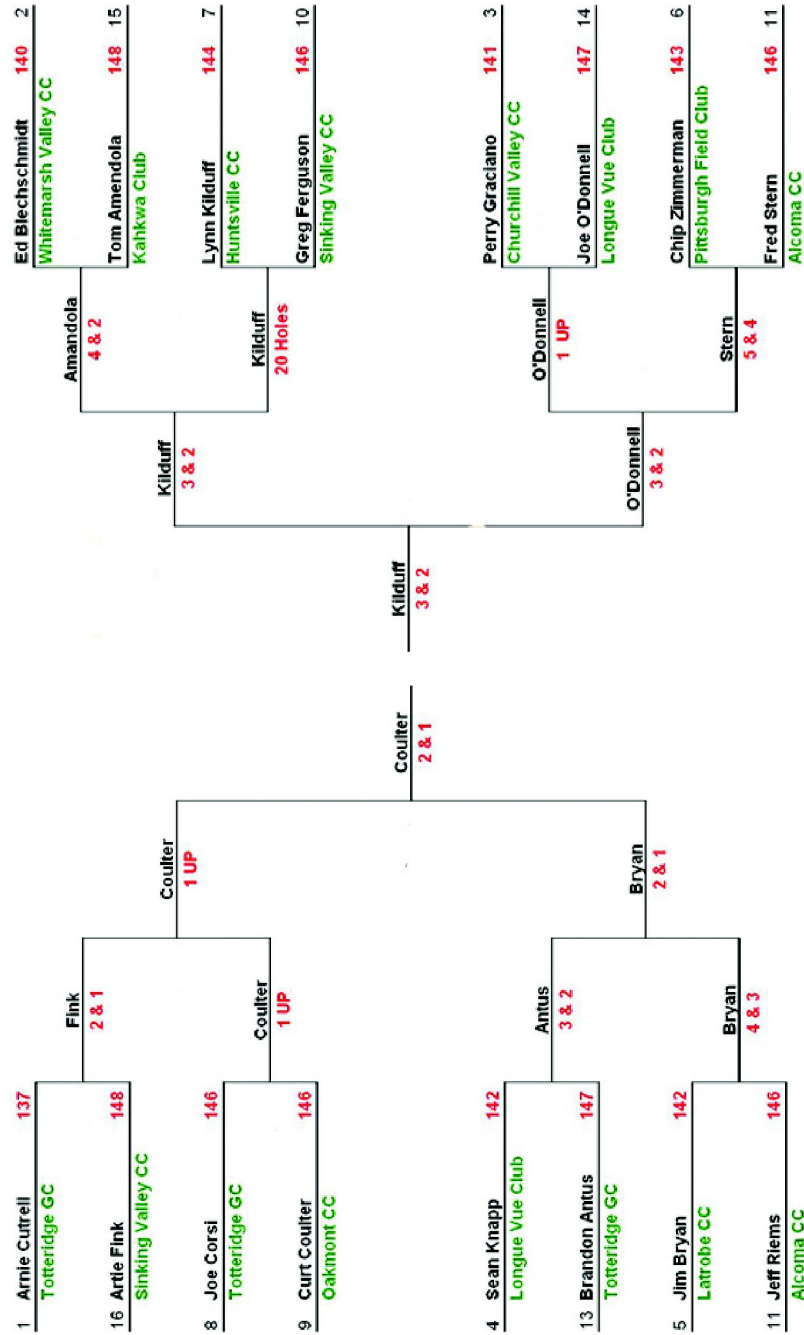

**F**AYETTEVILLE, Pa.—Craig Tallent of Merion GC wasted no time in decreeing the 53<sup>rd</sup> Junior Championship at Penn National Golf Club his tournament to have and to hold. Tallent, 16, of Ardmore, posted a first-round, 6-under-par 66 and followed that up with a scintillating birdie-birdie finish en route to a final round 71 and his first Junior Championship.

Tallent completed the tournament at 7-under-par 137, three shots clear of the field. Chad Avery Bricker of Waynesboro CC and Donald Thomas of Totteridge GC tied for second at 4-under-par.

It was the second lowest score posted since the Junior Championship switched in 1987 to its current format of two rounds of medal play.

"It's really fulfilling to see my name mentioned with those who have won this tournament in the past," said Tallent. "To be called the best junior golfer in Pennsylvania is special."

Tallent appeared to have the victory well in hand from the outset. He opened the tournament with a 6-under-par 66 on the Founders Course on day one before completing his front nine of the second round (on the Iron Forge Course) in 2-under-par 34.

However, the old adage of a tournament not beginning until the back nine of the final day proved prophetic. On his trek to the clubhouse, Tallent started becoming his own worst enemy. He bogeyed the short par 4, 12<sup>th</sup> (295 yards) and the par 3, 13<sup>th</sup> (183 yards), allowing a hint of doubt to creep into his mind. Another over-par score on No. 15 (par 4, 384 yards) had Tallent talking to himself, literally.

"I told myself I was getting way too analytical about what I was doing," said Tallent, "and I was worrying way too much about how the other guys were fairing."

Those other guys – Bricker, 16, of Wayneboro and Thomas, 15, of Murrysville – were busy fairing pretty well, slashing a one-time, four-stroke Tallent advantage to a single shot by the 17<sup>th</sup> hole.

"There was a little wait on the 16<sup>th</sup> tee," said Tallent, "and it gave me a little time to collect myself."

Tallent's renewed composure resulted in him almost flushing a 5-iron into the hole. His tee ball landed a foot from the cup before stopping 15 feet away. He two putted for par. Bricker and Thomas also made threes.

With the wheels now fully fastened, Tallent, in essence, secured the victory in style on No. 17 (par 5, 580 yards).

He made three birdies and three bogeys in recording even-par nine-hole scores of 36-35.

And on RG's difficult par 3s, he finished at 1-over-par for the two days.

"You can't wait for others to make mistakes," said Pieczynski. "If I'm going to go down, I'm going to go down with guns blazing."

"I made some birdies early on and Bernie made some key up-and-downs when we needed them in the middle of the round to keep the momentum going. We played solid the rest of the way doing the old ham and egg deal, one guy holding the other one up. In the end, we made out OK."

The Better-Ball Championship was scheduled to be a 36-hole event, however, weather forced a cancellation of the second round and scores reverted to the results from Day One.

Biamon made certain the duo opened with a flash (the two started on the back nine). The 41-year-old resident of Lower Gwynedd posted birdies on the 10<sup>th</sup> (par 4, 386 yards), 11<sup>th</sup> (par 4, 363 yards) and long and difficult 14<sup>th</sup> (par 3, 215 yards) to make his group 3-under-par after five holes.

"It was a nice start," said Biamon. "On the first hole I had a 30 footer up a big ledge onto the back of the green. And on No. 5 (14<sup>th</sup>), I hit a 5-iron to the middle of the green and had a 15-18 footer with a foot of break left. It was crazy."

Zbrzezny, who struggled early in the round, made clutch par saves on the 18<sup>th</sup> (par 4, 445 yards), No. 1 (par 4, 410 yards) and No. 2 (par 4, 419 yards) to keep the round going.

"I was just trying to find a way to help," said Zbrzezny of his three par saves. "The most challenging came on No. 2 (par 4, 419 yards). I drove it into the right fairway bunker but had no shot at the green. I managed to get it into the right grass bunker and was left with a really difficult chip

shot from a goat lie and the green running away from me. I hit a good chip, but it wouldn't stop rolling. I was left with a 12-foot uphill putt that broke left to right. I actually read it wrong, but I trusted Miguel's read and knocked it in."

Zbrzezny added a late birdie on No. 7 (par 4, 534 yards) to push his team to 4-under-par on the round and made "an incredible chip shot to save par," said Biamon, on No. 8 (par 3, 202 yards).

On the downhill 9<sup>th</sup> (par 4, 422 yards), the duo's 18<sup>th</sup> hole, Biamon split the fairway with a driver before dropping a sand wedge to three feet for an easy birdie.

"It was a great thrill," said Zbrzezny of winning. "The surprise was neither of us played well in the practice round. The wind was blowing

30 miles per hour and we thought it was the hardest golf course ever.

"The conditions calmed down on Monday, but I still thought 5-under-par was a great score. The course played long and the greens were lightning fast."

Bryan and Cutrell, who started early in the a.m., appeared to be the team to beat. They birdied their first four holes (No. 1-4), but one birdie in their final 14 to go along with one bogey.

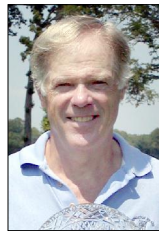

Stringfellow and Marek, both members at Carlisle CC, outlasted 1995 champions Richard Smith and Warren Deakins of Philadelphia

CC and 1998 victors Phil Saylor of Sunnehanna CC and Jim Anderson of Willowbrook CC by a stroke. Fred Tyler, Jr. of Reading CC and William Whitman of Berkshire CC, five-time winners of the event, finished two shots back.

"It's a good win anytime you win," Stringfellow said, "but a win at the state level gives you a level of satisfaction that is hard to match. It's nice to know that you can play with the top golfers from the state and to know that your game is as good as theirs."

Early on it appeared Stringfellow, 64, of Carlisle, and Marek, 58, of Camp Hill, were going to lap the field. Starting on the back nine of the Rees Jones design, the two carded seven

"At that point, not knowing the golf course was an advantage," said Stringfellow. "We just kept playing it one shot at a time. Bob or I would hit it in there and make the putt. It was easy."

"It was unbelievable," added Marek. "When Charlie made the 15-footer on the long par 3 (No. 14, 167 yards), our spirits were really up."

They made the turn in 6-under-par. That's also when the human factor, and that lack of familiarity with the course, turned against them.

The two bogeyed the short sixth (par 4, 299 yards) and barely escaped disaster on the slight dogleg right ninth (par 4, 396 yards) when Stringfellow made bogey after knocking his drive way left.

"[At the turn you] started thinking about what was going on," said Stringfellow. "I thought we could really go low. But we weren't familiar with the course and our club selection wasn't as good as it should have been on some holes."

"We don't play together very often," said Marek. "Thomas Verney, a friend of mine who I played with in last year's Senior Better-Ball Tournament, suggested I give Charlie a call. He said we could win this thing."

He was right.

# A. Fred Williamson Cup

Royal Montreal Golf Club – Montreal, Quebec, Canada  
Aug. 11-12, 2003

**G**arrett Basalyga of Talamore at Oak Terrace CC and Brandon Detweiler of Lancaster CC secured the top two individual slots in guiding the Pennsylvania Golf Association to its first-ever A. Fred Williamson Cup championship.

Team Pennsylvania finished the two days on the difficult Royal Montreal Golf Club (par 70) course in Montreal, Quebec, Canada, with a 442 total, four shots clear of the Golf Association of Ontario. The Metropolitan Golf Association placed third at 455 strokes and the Golf Association of Philadelphia took fourth with a 456 total.

Basalyga earned medalist honors at the Williamson Cup by carding a two-round score of 6-over-par 146 (73-73). Detweiler placed second at 7-over-par and another teammate, Matt Mattare of Saucon Valley CC, also finished in the top five at 9-over-par. Scott Deakins of St. Davids GC rounded out the Pennsylvania Golf Association foursome (161 total).

"It was just an honor to play in the event," said Basalyga. "To be part of the first Pennsylvania team to win it is great. To earn the medalist was an added bonus."

The A. Fred Williamson Cup started in 1964 as a 36-hole junior competition between five regional golf associations.

In 2001, the Williamson Cup expanded to 11 regional and state associations: Buffalo, Delaware, Metropolitan, N.Y., Michigan, Ontario, Pennsylvania, Philadelphia, Western Pennsylvania, Quebec, Rochester and Syracuse.

Four juniors represent each association with the low three out of four scores in each round counting toward the team's total.

Last year, the Pennsylvania Golf Association recorded its highest finish prior to this year with a fourth-place showing.

This year only 10 teams took part in the Williamson Cup. The Buffalo District Golf Association did not participate.

# USGA Men's State Team Championship

Charles River Country Club – Newton Centre, Mass.  
Sept. 16-18, 2003

**M**ichael McDermott of Llanerch Country Club, Chris Lange of Overbrook Golf Club and P. Chet Walsh of Philadelphia Country Club guided the Pennsylvania Golf Association to a 15<sup>th</sup> place tie in the 5<sup>th</sup> USGA Men's State Team Championship at Charles River Country Club (par 70, 6,513 yards) in Newton Centre, Mass.

Team Pennsylvania carded an 11-over-par 431 to finish in a tie for 15<sup>th</sup> out of 52 teams. All 50 states plus the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico competed. Louisiana and Michigan also finished at 11 over.

Members of Team Pennsylvania were selected based on their ranking in the William C. Fownes, Jr., Amateur Player of the Year standings. Points for the Player of the Year are awarded based on a player's finish in a variety of national, state and regional events. This information is then presented to the Pennsylvania Golf Association Championship Committee for their selection of the team. Sean Knapp of St. Jude GC and Nathan

Smith of Pinecrest Country Club were also asked to represent the team but could not compete.

At the Championship, with the approach of Hurricane Isabel imminent, the Championship Committee implemented a cut after 36 holes in order to complete the 54-hole event. A total of 36 teams made the cut at 13-over-par 294.

Tennessee, the eventual champion, was the only team to post a sub-par total on the third day as only eight players in the field broke par. Tennessee finished at 7-under-par.

The teams from California and North Carolina tied for second at 3-under-par.

The biennial event travels to the Berkeley Hall Club in Hilton Head, S.C., on Sept. 27- 29, 2005.

The State Team, for non-college, amateur golfers, was created in 1995 to celebrate the USGA's centennial.

# W.C. Fownes, Jr., Amateur Player of the Year

## Nathan Smith – Pinecrest Country Club



The inaugural race for the William C. Fownes, Jr., Amateur Player of the Year couldn't have been any closer, and for the winner, Nathan Smith of Pinecrest Country Club, the challenge couldn't have been any more daunting.

Smith, of Brookville, Pa., not only needed a victory at the U.S. Middle-Amateur Championship at Wilmington Country Club - a monumental accomplishment in itself - but also needed his closest foe, Michael McDermott of Llanerch Country Club (who advanced to the round of 16 at the U.S. Amateur) to exit after the first round.

When those mid-October days started to play out, it was obvious Smith's game was that of one of the top amateurs in the country. He would go on to become the youngest U.S. Middle-Amateur Champion at age 25. McDermott bowed out in the first round of match play.

William C. Fownes, Jr., the award's namesake earned the U.S. Amateur title in 1910 and was a four-time State Amateur titleholder (1910, '12, '13 and '16). Fownes was instrumental in the formation of the Walker Cup and was the team captain in 1922. From 1926-27, he served as the USGA President.
