## LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

As winter interrupts our golfing calendar in the Northeast, the annual break allows us time to reflect on the year just passed. The season will be remembered for the achievements of Sean Knapp, the inauguration of a match play championship that brought together the top players in the state and, unfortunately, the horrific weather that tried our patience.

Before I continue, however, I would like to thank all of our host clubs' staff, grounds crews and golfing members at our qualifying and championship venues for allowing us to use their facilities to have our events. Without each of you, the Pennsylvania Golf Association would fail to exist.

It is no surprise that Sean Knapp prevailed as the W.C. Fownes, Jr., Amateur Player of the Year. The 42-year-old resident of Oakmont, Pa., almost duplicated his remarkable performance of 1997 when he won both the state Amateur and Middle-Amateur championships in addition to tying for sixth in the Open. In July at this year's Amateur at Fox Chapel GC, Knapp finished second, four shots back of Blaine Peffley. This was his third runner-up finish. A month later in the Pennsylvania Open at Pittsburgh Field Club, Sean tied for fifth overall and also tied for low amateur honors. Only a few weeks more had passed when Knapp capped his strong year with a victory at the Pennsylvania Middle-Amateur Championship at Philadelphia Country Club. The win was Knapp's third Middle-Amateur crown.

In June, the Pennsylvania Golf Association conducted the inaugural R. Jay Sigel Amateur Match Play Championship at Aronimink GC. Jay Sigel's name and legacy were honored with this new championship that hosted 32 of Pennsylvania's top amateurs in a match play setting. Kyle Davis, an honorable mention Rolex Junior All-American from Kennett Square, Pa., won the inaugural championship over Greg Pieczynski of Kingston, Pa.

I would also like to congratulate Jarred Texter of Millersville, Pa., on being a first-team Rolex Junior All-American.

And, of course, who could forget the effects of the weather that interrupted the Amateur, Open and Better-Ball/Senior Better-Ball events. Mother Nature was not as cooperative as we had hoped this year.

Also, last summer, the Association sent a junior team to defend the A. Fred Williamson Cup title at the Country Club of Detroit in Grosse Pointe Farms, Mich. Team Pennsylvania finished in a second-place tie, two strokes behind the Metropolitan Golf Association. We look forward to another strong showing at Bent Creek CC in Litz, Pa., this year.

In 2005 we will be adding and conducting a new event: The Hemlock Championship, a two-day stroke-play event for men ages 45-54. The event will be held over two days in May. Our goal this year and every year is to conduct premier championships at superior venues that are professionally administered in all regards: from processing qualifying entry forms to the crowning of our deserving champions. We believe in the Rules of Golf, the traditions of etiquette and intense but fair competition. Golf in Pennsylvania is a wonderful game and we are dedicated to keeping it that way.

Congratulations to all the 2004 Pennsylvania State Champions. Everyone on the Executive Committee of the Pennsylvania Golf Association looks forward to a productive 2005.

# 1<sup>st</sup> R. Jay Sigel Match Play Championship

Aronimink Golf Club – Newtown Square, Pa.  
June 7-9, 2004

**K**yle Davis got off to a fast start and never looked back. Davis, 18, a plus-4 handicapper from Kennett Square G&CC, nailed a 300-yard drive on the par 4, 430-yard first hole at Aronimink GC in the final match, drained a 25-foot birdie putt and went on to beat Greg Pieczynski, 21, of Kingston, Pa., 5&4, to win the Pennsylvania Golf Association's inaugural R. Jay Sigel Match Play Championship.

Davis, a junior at Unionville High School, was seeded 15<sup>th</sup> in the select field of 32 players from throughout the state.

Pieczynski, a junior who plays No. 2 on the Penn State golf team, with a handicap of plus .3, was seeded 17<sup>th</sup>. He's a member of Irem Temple CC.

It was a battle of Unionville vs. Penn State, with both players' golf bags emblazoned with their school names and colors; Davis toting his own bag, and Pieczynski's dad, Ron, carrying his.

Davis, a left hander, quickly went 2-up in the match with a par on the 446-yard, par 4 third hole, after a shot from a greenside bunker to three feet. Pieczynski hit his approach over the green and failed to get up and down. It was one of four greens he over-shot on the day.

Both players, consistently driving the ball 290 yards or more off the tee, parred holes 4 and 5, bogeyed 6, and parred 7, before coming to the pivotal 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>.

On the par 3, downhill 237-yard 8<sup>th</sup>, Davis hit a 5-iron into a right greenside bunker, bladed the ball over the green and then chipped back to eight feet where his putt went in and then out of the hole, bringing him to his knees. Pieczynski hit the green and parred the hole, cutting the deficit to 1-down.

But Davis quickly regained the advantage on No. 9, an uphill, 556-yard par 5. He hit his drive 290, smoked a 260-yard 3-wood to just off the front of the green, chipped to 3 feet and birdied the hole to go 2-up.

Both scrambled and bogeyed the long, 454-yard, par 4 10<sup>th</sup> hole, as Davis hit his drive into trees on the right and lipped out an 8-foot par putt. Pieczynski again hit an approach on the flag but over the green.

On the 11<sup>th</sup>, a 413-yard par 4, Davis again hit his drive 290, and was outdriven by Pieczynski 30 yards. Both parred, with Davis lipping out, again, a 10-footer for birdie.

The match turned on the 12<sup>th</sup>, a 465-yard par 4. Both players missed the green left after drives of 295 yards. After Pieczynski missed an eight-footer, Davis rolled his putt in from five feet to go 3-up.

On the 13<sup>th</sup>, a short, 393-yard par 4, Davis, conservatively, hit the fairway with a rescue club, and Pieczynski, using a driver, buried his first shot under the lip of a left fairway bunker. Davis, with a par, went 4-up.

Pieczynski had one last glimmer of hope on the 218-yard, par 3 14<sup>th</sup>, where he chipped to within three feet from the front fringe and watched Davis ram a 40-foot putt 12 feet past. But Davis holed the tough, downhill putt, and Pieczynski missed the 3-footer, ending the match.

Davis' medal score was 1-over par to that point, with the tees back at 7,152 yards and flags tucked into Sunday tour positions.

Davis, who last year captured the Golf Association of Philadelphia's Junior Boys' Championship and also advanced to match play at the U.S. Junior Amateur Championship, called the Sigel victory "my best win ever, on an awesome golf course," which he had played for the first time during a prac-

tice round Sunday.

"I hit the ball well, made a lot of putts and the breaks seemed to go my way," he said.

He credited two people for his success in golf. One is his brother, Jonathan, a plus-1 handicapper who plays on the Oglethorpe (Ga.) University golf team, who constantly challenged him. "Wanting to beat my brother, now those were my really important matches," he grinned.

The other is his coach, Mike Dynda, director of instruction at Blue Bell CC and golf coach at Drexel University, who walked by his side throughout the tournament. "Mike's been my coach since the sixth grade," he said. "But he's more than a coach. He's as much a friend as he is an awesome teacher."

Pieczynski, said hitting the ball over four greens hurt him. "I don't know whether it was adrenaline or the warm air," he said. "I executed the shots the way I wanted to, but I just miscalculated, and you can't make those kind of tactical, strategic mistakes, especially on this course.

"But," he added, "Kyle played great. It wasn't like I lost it. Kyle just won it. I can't have any regrets when Kyle played like that."

# 91<sup>st</sup> Amateur Championship

Fox Chapel Golf Club – Pittsburgh, Pa.  
July 26-28, 2004

**B**laine Peffley of Lebanon Country Club started his final round of the 91<sup>st</sup> Amateur Championship in the second to last group and a shot back of Chip Zimmerman from Pittsburgh Field Club. An ideal position, the 19 year old thought, to “sneak up” on the leaders.

Standing on the 18<sup>th</sup> tee some four hours later, Peffley's secretive plan resulted in an ambush.

Peffley, of Lebanon, Pa., lapped the field by four shots, finishing at 10-under par on a wet and soggy Fox Chapel GC. A tor-

rental rain storm on Monday forced the field of 132 to be cut to the low 40 players and ties after the first round. Typically, the cut is after two rounds of

play. Competitors who survived the cut played 36 holes on the third and final day.

“It was more a battle of attrition,” said Peffley, who commented that not playing a practice round earlier in the week when the course was hard and fast proved more beneficial than not. “It was whose mind could hold up during the rain delays.”

The title was Peffley's first Amateur Championship and second state crown. Peffley captured the 2002 Junior Championship.

“Three years in a row I finished second in the Junior before winning,” said Peffley. “I didn't want to start that trend again in the Amateur. It was really nice to come out and bring it home down the stretch.”

Peffley finished the tournament with rounds of 65 and 67 after posting an opening-round 68.

Sean Knapp of St. Jude GC, the 1997 champion, was runner-up for the third time after posting rounds of 67-67-70 (6-under par).

“Chip was playing some of the most spectacular golf I'd seen in some time, so I just wanted to keep hanging around and see if something miraculous happened at the end,” said Knapp, 42, of Oakmont, Pa. “Chip faltered a little and I was playing well, but Blaine did what it takes to win.”

Peffley started the day three strokes back of first-round



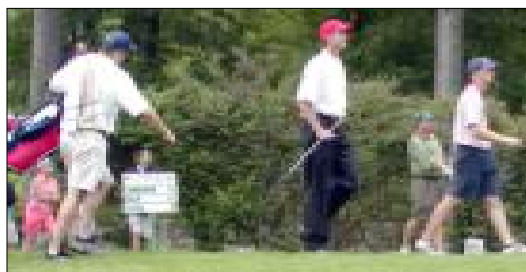

leader Chip Zimmerman, but after a second-round 65 stood only a shot behind. Keeping that low profile, he mentioned, Peffley turned it on in his final five holes, registering four birdies and a par. Peffley registered three consecutive birdies when he: lasered a sand wedge from 100 yards to a foot on No. 14 (par 4, 408 yards); dropped a gap wedge to five feet on No. 15 (par 4, 383 yards); and a pitching wedge that he left about 40-feet short to a back pin on No. 16 (par 4, 422 yards) that he ended up “pouring” in. A solid par on the long par 3, 231-yard 17<sup>th</sup>, a 4-iron and two putts, preceded a birdie on the long, par 5, 18<sup>th</sup> hole (574 yards) in which he bombed a driver, 2-iron over the green. He got up and down for the four and a final-round 67.

“After two years of struggle [at college], it finally all came together. I'm happy to be home [and more] comfortable,” said Peffley, who is set to transfer to the University of Maryland after spending two years at the University of Arizona. “I feel more comfortable on the East Coast.”

His record in the Amateur proves out that statement: a fourth-place showing in 2002 at Oakmont CC and a tie for 12<sup>th</sup> last year at the CC of Scranton. He also posted a home-course record of 61 the week prior to the championship.

Arnie Cutrell of Totteridge GC finished in third place with rounds of 67-69-69. Zimmerman finished in fourth place and Rich Berglund of Oakmont CC rounded out the top five by finishing at 3-under-par 207.

# 88<sup>th</sup> Frank B. Fuhrer Pennsylvania Open

Pittsburgh Field Club – Pittsburgh, Pa.

**T**he Pennsylvania Open came at a perfect time for Ryan Sikora and his game.

The 26-year-old assistant professional from Edgewood CC in Pittsburgh posted rounds of 67-68-69 to finish at 9-under par and atop the leaderboard of the 88<sup>th</sup> Frank B. Fuhrer Open Championship at Pittsburgh Field Club (par 71, 6,636 yards). Sikora, who earned \$10,000 for the victory, finished four shots clear of Bob Ford, the longtime head professional from Oakmont CC. Stu Ingraham, the head professional at Overbrook GC, and Steve Wheatcroft, a touring professional and the defending Pennsylvania Open champion, tied for third place at 4-under.

"Everything just clicked in the Open," said Sikora, a resident of North Huntingdon, Pa. "I had three second-[place finishes] and a bunch of top fives [in the Tri-State Section of the PGA], but that week it all came together. It was the best I hit the ball all summer." He hit 15 greens a day in regulation.

Sikora entered the third and final round with a three-shot advantage.

A spot he didn't learn about until he arrived at the golf course on Day Three.

"I didn't find out until that morning I had a three-shot lead because of the rain delay," said Sikora, who just missed the nasty weather that hindered a majority of competitors in round two. "I wanted to get off to a good start in my first five holes [of the final round] and then see what happened."

Sikora opened by going 1-under par in his first handful of holes. On the long, par 3 sixth hole (222 yards), he recorded a bogey four to drop a shot to the field and see his lead

dwindle to one.

After 10 holes, Sikora's edge was two shots over Ford and Jim Cichra, a professional from Pittsburgh, before a three-birdie-in-three-hole stretch resolved any suspense.

Sikora overcame a shaky drive on 11 (par 5, 525 yards) before sinking a six-footer for birdie. On the 12<sup>th</sup> (par 4, 469 yards), Sikora pulled a 5-iron left over the greenside bunker. However, his 50-foot chip rattled the flag and fell into the hole. Capping off a championship push, Sikora rocketed a driver just short of the 13<sup>th</sup> (par 4, 332 yards) green, chipped to a foot and tapped in for his third consecutive under-par score.

After that, "I just tried to hit the middle of the greens coming in and

make pars."

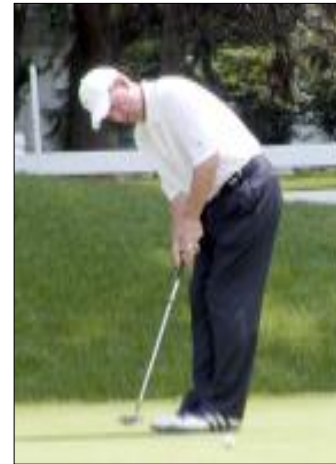
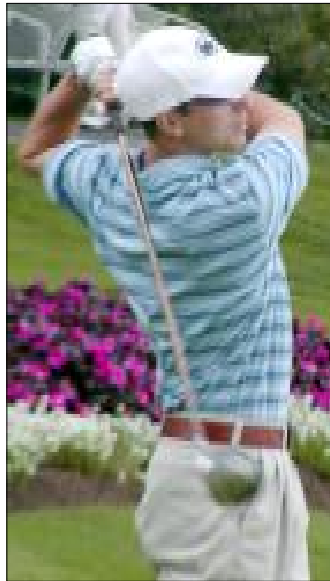
He finished with four level scores and a final-hole bogey for a round of 2-under-par 69.

Ford, a three-time Open Champion ('77, '81 and '93), carded a third-round 70 to go along with a pair of 69s.

"I was feeling good through 11 holes," said Ford, "then Ryan [Sikora] turned it on and played beautifully. He deserved to win."

Wheatcroft and Ingraham posted even-par final round scores of 71. Ingraham is also a past champion, taking the 1998 title.

A total of 46 players made the cut from the field of 132 players. Of that group, 27 were professionals and 19 were amateurs. The professionals were playing for a total purse of \$50,000.

Sean Knapp of St. Jude GC survived a treacherous track and staunch field to capture the 11<sup>th</sup> Middle-Amateur Championship at Philadelphia CC (par 71, 6,865 yards). Knapp finished at 1-over par for the 36 holes to become the first player in Pennsylvania Golf Association history to capture three Middle-Amateur championships.

Chris Lange of Overbrook GC and Glenn Smeraglio of Yardley CC tied for second a shot back. Three others finished at 5-over par to round out the top five.

"I think the state events are penultimate for amateurs, exclusive of USGA events," said Knapp, 42, of Oakmont, Pa. "This means a lot. I felt I haven't

done enough, in terms of victories, in state events."

Maybe Knapp's win total isn't what he wants it to be, but his resume is truly remarkable.

In addition to capturing three state Middle-Amateur titles (1996 at Lancaster CC and 1997 at Longue Vue Club), Knapp has finished in the top five in the last 10 state amateurs he's competed in, including a 1997 victory at the Country Club of Scranton, and has qualified for a remarkable 17 USGA championships. He's a household name in national amateur circles.

The Middle-Amateur Championship changed to a 36-hole, stroke play format this year. Prior, the champion was determined through medal play qualifying and a match play draw.

Knapp, who was in a six-way tie for the lead after carding an opening-round 72, posted a level-par 71 to secure the title.

He birdied No. 1 (par 4, 325 yards) but bogeyed No. 2 (par 4, 353 yards) from 75 yards out when he found the greenside bunker. Another under-par score on No. 8 (par 4, 380 yards) watched Knapp turn in 1-under-par 35. He offset a bogey on No. 11 (par 3, 181 yards) with a six-foot birdie on No. 13 (par 4, 380 yards) before securing the victory on No. 14 (par 4, 472 yards). Knapp pounded a driver, 6-iron to 40 feet behind the flag. A quick, downhill putt,

Knapp's chance fell in for an unexpected three.

"I was just trying to find a way to make a bogey [on the difficult 16th]," said Knapp, continuing his round recap. "I got it into the right rough and tried to hit a little chip 9-iron to get it to roll up. It rolled up [almost] onto the 11<sup>th</sup> hole." Knapp chipped out sideways and then missed his five-foot bogey opportunity.

Knapp then finished with two solid pars, including a nifty 5-wood chip to two feet on No. 18 (par 4, 392 yards) that he sank for par.

Lange, 49, of Bryn Mawr, Pa., posted the lowest round of the day, a 2-under-par 69. Smeraglio, 44, of Yardley, Pa., also finished in red digits on Day Two with a 1-under-par 70.

"I was trying to shoot 68," said Smeraglio, who carded four birdies, a double bogey and a bogey. "I birdied No. 1 and No. 2 and was off and running. Then I hit a very uncharacteristic [block drive] into the woods on No. 9 and had to take an unplayable."

Lange carded four birdies and two bogeys on his round. The 50-year-old captured the Golf Association of Philadelphia Open Championship at Philadelphia CC two months earlier.

The 2005 Middle-Amateur Championship is set for Sept. 12-13 at the Country Club of York.

Chad Bricker had a simple answer when asked to describe the key to his winning the 54<sup>th</sup> Pennsylvania Junior Championship at Penn National GC.

"Hard work pays off," he said.

Bricker, 17, a high school senior from Waynesboro CC, carded a 2-under-par 70 for a two-round total of 2-under-par 142 to take home the title.

He started the day two strokes behind Jimmy Markovitz of The Club at Nevillewood, but quickly erased that deficit. Bricker, who finished second to Craig Tallent of Merion GC in the 2003 Junior Championship, birdied the first two holes and was off and running.

"I went out thinking I had to shoot a 67," said Bricker heading into round two on the Iron Forge Course (par 72, 6,877 yards). "I was kind of disappointed last year. I played real well and I thought it was [good] enough. But that pushed me a little harder and it means more winning it this year."

Bricker's final-round score of 70 topped Markovitz by a stroke. Markovitz, the first-round leader after carding a 2-under-par 70, came back with a 1-over 73 in the final round.

"I always play better from behind," said Bricker.

And when asked why that is so? "I tend to play more aggressive. Everyone knows it's harder to sleep on a lead."

Markovitz started slowly, posting a 2-over 38 on the front nine, but rebounded with a 1-under 35 on the back. "I knew I had to finish strong," he said, "because I heard he was 3-under. I'll just come back next year."

Jeff Greist of Waynesborough CC, finished third with rounds of 74-70-144.

Bricker served notice from the beginning, posting a birdie-birdie-par-birdie start. But maybe Bricker's best effort came on No. 15 (par 4, 404 yards). A perfect drive left Bricker with 90 yards to the putting surface. Playing into the wind, his sand wedge spun back off the green some 30 feet. However, Bricker's chip shot came up short and he needed to drain a 15-footer to save par and the lead.

Paul Schlachter of The Club at Nevillewood, an honors history teacher at Upper St. Clair High School in Pittsburgh, added another chapter to his impressive textbook sized resume at Saucon Valley CC (par 72, 6, 575 yards, Grace Course).

Schlachter, 55, of Pittsburgh, earned his first Pennsylvania Senior Amateur Championship (55 years of age and older) title with a final score of even-par 144 on the difficult Grace Course with its treacherous greens. Schlachter carded rounds of 68-76 to distance himself from the other 131 players in the field.

He adds the Senior Amateur title to a list of accomplishments that already includes the 1988 Pennsylvania Amateur Championship and five USGA National Championship appearances.

"It's a big deal to win both the state Amateur and Senior, especially for the resume," said Schlachter. "It's terrific and at a place like this, it's wonderful. Pennsylvania's [viewed as] one of the top states for golf.

Thomas R. Davis of Saucon Valley CC and Michael Sanger of Merion GC tied for second at 146, two strokes behind the leader. David K. Brookreson of Huntingdon Valley CC and Peter Smith of The Kahkwa Club placed fourth at 151.

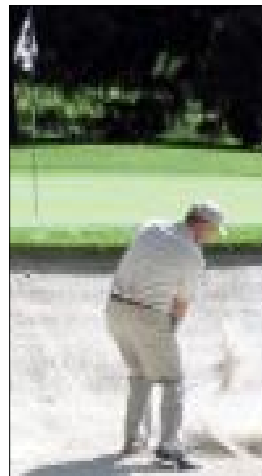

Schlachter entered the final day of the 36-hole tournament with a four-shot lead over Davis and company. However, a 2-over-par 38 on the front preceded bogeys on No. 10 (par 5, 515 yards) and No. 13 (par 4, 328 yards) to drop Schlachter to even par. He drilled a 6-iron to three feet on No. 14 (par 3, 150 yards) to get back into red figures, but failed to get up and down on No. 18 (par 4, 405 yards) to finish with a second-round 76. The day was a reversal of his torrid opening-round 68 (which including an opening-nine score of 31, on the back side).

"I kept making the wrong choices with my irons," said Schlachter, who registered only nine greens in regulation. "I didn't hit it solid. I was just hanging on. I bogeyed the second hole (No. 2, par 4, 384 yards) from the right rough and was never sharp the rest of the day."

A constant breeze, lightening fast greens and the pressures of a final round appeared to take its toll on everybody, however.

Davis, who began play in the afternoon, and after Schlachter finished, grabbed the lead at the turn, knowing what he had to do. Starting on the back nine, Davis netted birdies on No. 16 (par 4, 425 yards) and No. 17 (par 4, 410 yards) to finish the front with an impressive 1-under-par 35. At the time, he led Schlachter by two strokes.

The turning point then came a few holes later on No. 8 (par 4, 382 yards), his 17<sup>th</sup> hole.

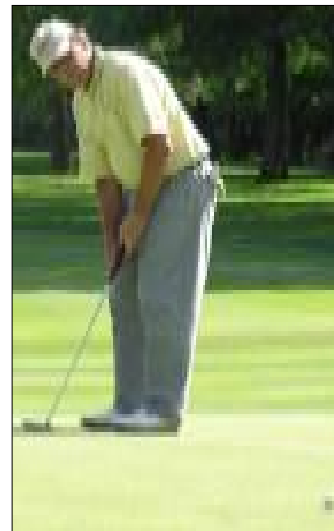
A drive left Davis with 155 yards. His 8-iron to a tight hole location came up a yard short and into the left bunker. He just missed saving par.

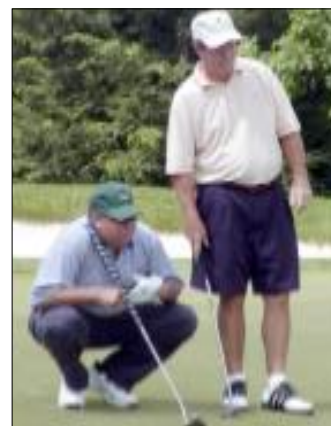

Facing a tough, downhill shot with little green to work with, Adams

One of the keys to his steady play, he said, was a new driver he had just begun to use. That, and the fact that he had no three-putts over 36 holes.

"The new driver gave me confidence," he said. "I kept it in play, didn't make too many mistakes and didn't three-putt."

By the 14<sup>th</sup> hole in the second round he knew he was in the lead. "It was a different feeling," he smiled. "I was pretty pumped."

**D**an Burton of Bent Creek CC, a longtime member of the Pennsylvania Golf Association Executive Committee, survived blustery conditions and a field of 212

players to finish 6-over-par and atop the

leaderboard of the 12<sup>th</sup> Senior Tournament. The victory was Burton's second state title (he also won the 1994 Middle-Amateur Championship) and

first Senior Tournament victory. The Senior Tournament is a two-day, 36-hole stroke play event with competitors playing 18 holes at each of the event's two venues – Blue Ridge CC and Colonial CC.

"I'm amazed, but I'm thrilled," said Burton, 55, of Lititz, Pa. "I

thought I had a chance at winning if I could shoot a 78, but then when I made the eight [on the 16th hole], I thought that was that."

Burton entered the final round with a four-shot lead after posting an impressive first-round 68 at Blue Ridge CC (par 72, 6,260 yards) on Day One. On Day Two at Colonial CC (par 72, 6,312 yards), with difficult windy conditions resulting in higher scores at both courses, Burton carded an almost disastrous 82.

Burton started the final round in cruise control and posted an even-par 36 on the front nine. He birdied No. 1 (par 4, 391 yards) and bogeyed No. 9 (par 4, 359 yards).

However, the round started to fall apart on the 10<sup>th</sup> hole (par 4, 371 yards). He three-putted the 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> holes for bogey. On No. 15 (par 4, 383 yards), Burton failed to get up and down from the bunker for a double bogey. On the par-4, 387-yard 16<sup>th</sup> hole, Burton thought he lost the tournament when his drive landed in a pine tree and was never found. His second ball hit the tree again, but

he found that one and was forced to chip out, twice in fact. Burton finished the hole with a quadruple bogey.

Burton posted a pair of pars on the final two holes – No. 17 (par 3, 140 yards) and No. 18 (par 4, 402 yards) – for a final-round score of 82 and 150 total to edge Don Lamb of St. Clair CC (72-79-151) by a shot. David Gale of Stonewall (76-76-152) placed third.

"I was thinking more about the team than about any individual [honors]," said Lamb, 63, of Pittsburgh, Pa. "I'm actually surprised."

The 2005 Williamson Cup is set for Aug. 8-9 at Bent Creek CC in Lititz, Pa. The Golf Association of Philadelphia is the host organization.

# W.C. Fownes, Jr., Amateur Player of the Year

## Sean Knapp – St. Jude Golf Club

Sean Knapp of St. Jude GC entered the 2004 season in a year-plus long funk. He ended the year on one of the most impressive rolls witnessed in some time on the state level: a Middle-Amateur Championship victory, top five showings in both the Pennsylvania Amateur and Pennsylvania Open and the recipient of the William C. Fownes, Jr., Player of the Year Award.

Knapp recorded 844 points, 116 points clear of second-place finisher Chris Lange of Overbrook GC. Reigning Player of the Year Michael McDermott of Llanerch CC placed sixth.

"It was unexpected," said the 42-year-old Knapp of earning Player of the Year honors. "The way my last year and a half went, I wasn't playing by best golf. [But] after the state amateur, I felt a shift in the direction [of my game]. [From there] I rode the crest of the wave in."

As the Oakmont, Pa., resident stated, his fortunes took a turn for the better starting in the 91<sup>st</sup> Amateur Championship held at Fox Chapel GC in late July. In the end, he finished second to Blaine Peffley of Lebanon CC and was

a fixture atop the leaderboard for all three days.

In the Frank B. Fuhrer Open Championship a couple of weeks later at Pittsburgh Field Club, Knapp continued his solid play with a top five effort. He finished tied with Peffley and Greg Pieczynski of Irem Temple CC for low amateur honors.

A month and some days later, Knapp traveled east to Philadelphia CC and edged Chris Lange of Overbrook GC for the Middle-Amateur Championship, his third state Mid-Am title.

This was the first year the Middle-Amateur Championship was a two-day stroke-play event.
