LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

I'm pleased to announce that your Association remains strong and thriving. Last year, the Pennsylvania Golf Association witnessed an increase in participation, up 30 percent from the year prior. The Amateur Championship, Open Championship, Senior Better-Ball Championship and Senior Tournament/Senior Team Championship all witnessed significant participant increases.

However, none of that would have been possible if not for the unwavering support of every Pennsylvania Golf Association member club and its professional staffs and ground crews. To all those clubs who have hosted or will host an event in the future, I thank you.

I would also like to recognize the Pennsylvania Golf Association Executive Committee, the staff and all the volunteers for their time and effort in making this a successful year.

Congratulations to Alex Knoll, the recipient of the 2005 W.C. Fownes, Jr. Award given to the Pennsylvania Golf Association's Amateur Player of the Year. Alex's season started out with a third-place finish at the George Dressler Amateur Public Links in May. In June, Knoll birdied the first playoff hole at a newly redesigned White Manor Country Club to capture the Pennsylvania Better-Ball and claim the Mayor's Trophy for him and his partner Christian Davis. Also early in the year, Knoll qualified for the U.S. Amateur Public Links Championship at Shaker Run Golf Club in Dublin, Ohio. In July, Knoll was crowned the victor of the Pennsylvania Amateur Championship held at Huntingdon Valley Country Club and, in August, he qualified for match play of the U.S. Amateur at Merion Golf Club in Ardmore, Pa.

The Association saw strong support for its first stand alone Senior Better-Ball Championship played at Huntsville Golf Club, northwest of Wilkes Barre, Pa. Bill Kunsman and Paul Schlachter from The Club at Nevillewood captured the title. Paul demonstrated his winning ways again later in the year by taking the Mid-Amateur Championship, his fourth state title, at The Country Club of York by edging out James Bohn, the 2002 Middle-Amateur Champion, in a playoff. Bill Davidson of Carlisle Country Club and Jim Sherratt of Old York Road Country Club won the Super-Senior Better-Ball division.

The Association administered the inaugural Hemlock Championship for golfers between the ages of 45 and 54. The event was played over two rounds at Bellewood Golf Club, a par 71, 6,609-yard layout, and was won by Robin McCool of Saucon Valley Country Club.

Those two events, plus the twofold increase in the entries at the George Dressler Amateur Public Links Championship helped add to our successful year. The Dressler was again held at the scenic Dauphin Highlands Golf Course in Harrisburg. Pete Toole, the 2000 Amateur Champion, from Mt. Joy, Pa., earned the title by stroke over newly reinstated amateur Jeff Daniels, the 2001 Open Champion.

Also, the Senior Team Championship held at the beautiful Philadelphia Cricket Club proved wildly successful. A full field of 320 golfers teed it up on the Militia Hill and Wissahickon courses.

Congratulations to Arnie Cutrell of Totteridge Golf Club for his victory in the R. Jay Sigel Amateur Match Play Championship played at scenic Stonewall in Elverson, Pa.

Sean Farren of Totteridge Golf Club blistered the final nine in 5-under 31 to overcome a four-stroke deficit and edge out Kevin Shields of Bethel Park, Pa., to capture the 89th Pennsylvania Open held at Sunnybrook Golf Club.

I would also like to congratulate King Knox of Lancaster Country Club for his Senior Amateur Championship victory at Butler Country Club and Jimmy Markovitz who took the Junior Championship at Penn National Golf Club in Fayetteville, Pa., with a 6-under par performance.

During the summer months, Pennsylvania sent a team of Juniors to the Williamson Cup which was hosted by the Golf Association of Philadelphia at Bent Creek Country Club in Lititz, Pa. For the second straight year the Pennsylvania Junior Team finished in second place. We look forward to another strong finish in Syracuse, N.Y., in 2006.

In September, the team of Sean Knapp, Chris Lange and Nathan Smith represented the Commonwealth at the USGA's State Team Championship held at the Berkeley Hall Club in Hilton Head, S.C. The team finished in sixth place behind Texas, Alabama, Tennessee, South Carolina and North Carolina and gave the Commonwealth its best finish in the event's history.

In closing I want to thank each and every one of you for letting me serve as your President this past year. I hope the 2005 season leaves you with great memories of a great organization that strives to increase your affection and love for the game of golf in Pennsylvania.



2nd R. Jay Sigel Match Play Championship

Stonewall – Elverson, Pa.
May 2-4, 2005

ELVERSON, Pa.—In a classic duel between East and West, Arnold Cutrell of Greensburg, Pa., near Pittsburgh, defeated Glenn Smeraglio, of Newtown, Pa., in suburban Philadelphia, on the 19th hole to win the Pennsylvania Golf Association's second R. Jay Sigel Pennsylvania Amateur Match Play Championship at Stonewall (par 70, 6,652 yards).

It was a dramatic finish for a back-and-forth match that featured only six halved holes and clutch, match-saving putts by Cutrell on holes No. 17 and 18, the latter after his 167-yard, downhill, downwind 8-iron hit four feet up on the flagstick at the back of the green and clanged to a stop 12 feet away.

One-down at the time, he drained the difficult, slick 12-footer to send the match into extra holes.

Then on the playoff par 5, 511-yard No. 1, after he extricated his drive from under the lip of a fairway bunker, pitched to 15 feet and missed a birdie by inches, he watched as Smeraglio's three-foot par putt dipped into the hole and then out, three quarters of the way around the cup.

“The golf gods,” he said, “were with me today.”

Cutrell, 40, is a former professional who played briefly as a Monday qualifier on the Nationwide Tour, and in several satellite tours in the 1980s before regaining his amateur status in 1994. He plays to a plus-3 handicap out of Totteridge GC, a course founded and designed by golf architect Rees Jones. He was 3-up after eight holes on a gray, cool, windless day, after Smeraglio found a greenside bunker on No. 1, scraped up a double bogey on the short, 370-yard No. 4, losing to a bogey, and missed an eight-foot par putt on No. 8.

“I thought I was in good shape then,” Cutrell said. “I felt I just had to play steady golf from there on to win. But Glenn played excellently from nine on in.”

Smeraglio, 44, got one back on No. 9, a tough, 219-yard par 3 over a large expanse of water, when he hit a 4-iron to 25 feet after Cutrell pulled his 4-iron left into the drink, just short of the green.

He then picked up another hole on the 395-yard, par 4 No. 10, where he hit a wedge from 138 yards to 10 feet and sunk the putt for a birdie to cut the deficit to 1-down, only to go 2-down again on the par 5, 585-yard No. 11, where he left a fat wedge well short of the green and missed from 12 feet for a bogey six.

But he cut the margin to one again on the next hole, a 346-yard par 4, with a birdie from six feet, and evened the match on the 187-yard, par 3 15th, when Cutrell three-putted from 60 feet.

With the momentum on his side, Smeraglio took the lead on the brutal, 463-yard, par four 16th, where he hit his shot of the day, a 140-foot, lob wedge chip from deep rough short of the green to five feet for a par. Cutrell missed from 35 feet for a bogey.

On No. 17, a short, 142-yard par 3, it looked like it was all over for Cutrell. He missed his tee shot badly, leaving it 25 feet short of the green on the edge of a bunker, while Smeraglio had a 20-footer for the match. Cutrell chipped to five feet, Smeraglio missed by inches, and Cutrell sank the five-footer to extend the match.

On 18, the long-hitting Cutrell, who had outdriven Smeraglio by 30 yards, as he had most of the day, said, “When I saw Glenn on the green, I knew I needed a birdie to win. I was pumped up. I hit the [8-iron] high and hard. If it hadn't hit the flagstick it would have been over the green. The golf gods were with me today.”

He said this, his first Pennsylvania state title, even after qualifying once for the U.S. Amateur, and making match play in the last three U.S. Middle-Amateurs, was very special.

“When I was growing up, Jay Sigel was Mr. Amateur Golf,” he said. “He was a great player and a great person. I'm honored to win this tournament in his name.”

Cutrell graduated from Wake Forest University, as did Sigel, but he didn't play on the golf team, which won the NCAA Championship while he was there in 1986, with such future pros as Len Mattiace and Billy Andrade.

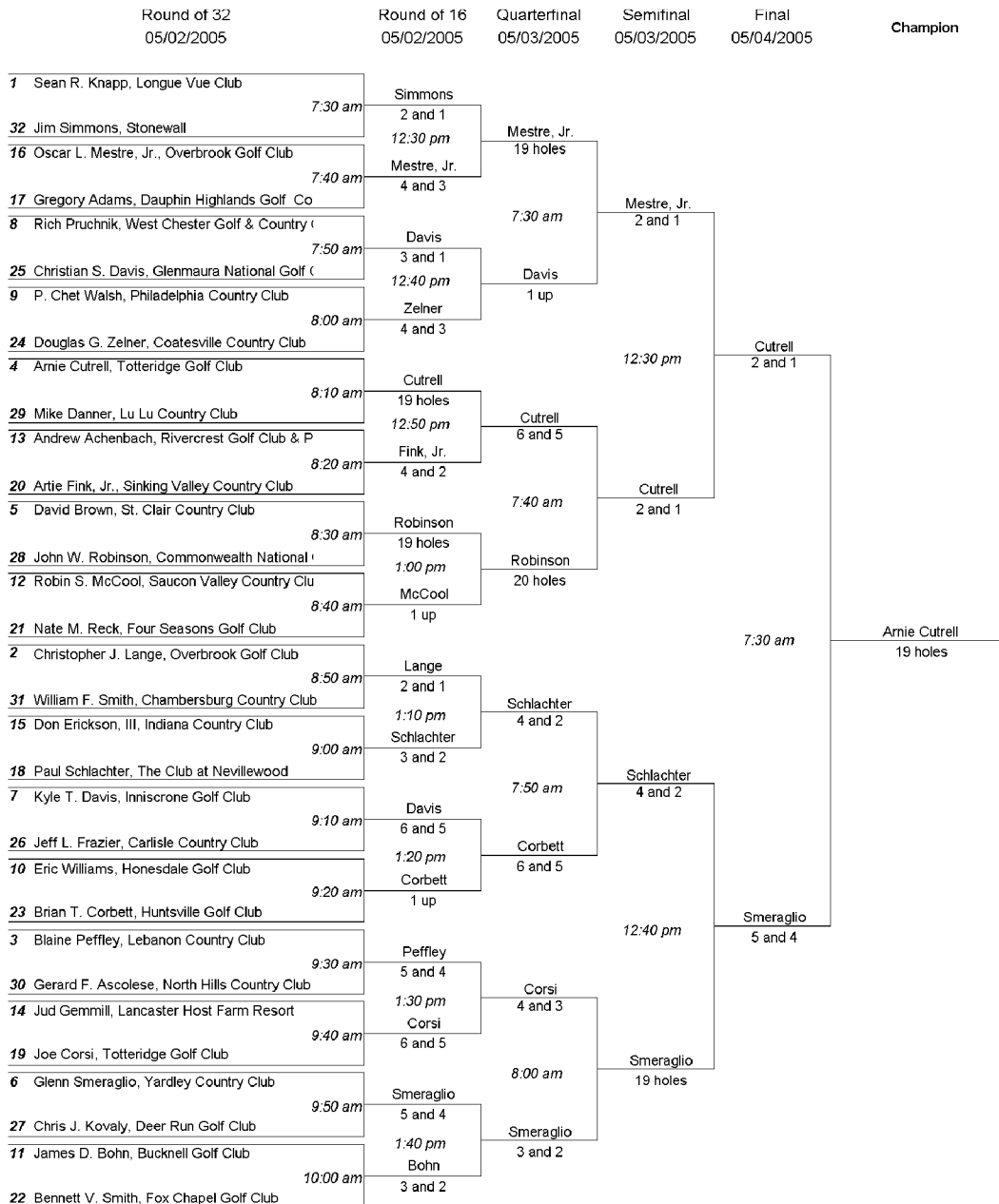
Smeraglio, after he lipped out the three-footer on 19 to end the match, was visibly disappointed on the course. But he took the loss stoically, and with class, back in the clubhouse.

“I'm an emotional guy,” he said. “It was a tough, three days. When you're 1-up and you par 18, especially with the flagstick back, you're going to win 99 percent of the time.”

“But he hit great shots at great times, and that's how you win golf tournaments. It was a strong field with good players and I'm proud to get as far as I got.”

HUNTINGDON VALLEY, Pa. – Alex Knoll, 20, of Bethlehem GC, repelled a challenge from home course favorite Randy Rolfe and fellow collegiate Dan Walters of Conestoga CC to complete a gate-to-wire victory in the 92nd Amateur Championship at Huntingdon Valley CC.

Knoll posted a final-round 70 to finish at 2-under par (208).

He was the only competitor to finish the 54 holes in red figures. Rolfe and Walters (211), who birdied the final hole, tied for second place three shots behind.

"I thought my greatest moment in golf was qualifying for the U.S. Amateur last week, but this tops that," said Knoll, a junior at Davidson University. "I'm just so happy to win. This was a great field on a great golf course.

"When I finished the first round in the dark [on Monday] and I was leading, I said I can win this tournament." Knoll posted a pair of 69s to enter the third and final round with a one-shot lead.

However, a couple of bad swings early and a strong push by Rolfe put Knoll two shots behind the hometown favorite heading to the ninth hole (par 4, 460 yards) of the final round. That's where Rolfe found trouble off the tee. Then his second shot, from the right fescue, landed in the valley short of the green and his chip checked up to about 20 feet below the hole. Knoll's approach on the downhill ninth left him with a difficult 12-foot birdie chance. Rolfe's first

putt came up about three feet short and he missed that. Knoll poured in his birdie opportunity and in the blink of an eye the Bethlehem resident went from two shots back to one stroke ahead. Knoll never trailed again.

"That was a big boost," said Knoll, wearing his lucky red Davidson golf shirt.

Added Rolfe, "That took the steam out of me. I hadn't made any

mistakes like that the whole tournament until then."

Knoll drained a short birdie on No. 11 (par 4, 372 yards), and converted clutch up-and-downs on Nos. 13 (par 3, 184 yards), 14 (par 4, 467 yards) and 16 (par 4, 400 yards) to keep his competitors at arm's length.

"Those were more key to the victory than anything," said Knoll, a resident of Bethlehem, Pa.

On 13, a par 3 guarded by a lake, Knoll pushed his 8-iron right and left his chip 10 feet short. He made the putt.

On 14, his 3-iron landed in the bunker 40 yards short of the green. His bunker blast stopped 15 feet from the hole. He made that putt as well.

On 16, still up by four shots at the time, he rolled his approach shot off the back fringe of the green. A delicate chip from an uphill slope, the ball stopped six feet shy. He drained it.

A bogey on No. 17 (par 3, 211 yards) resulted after a pulled 6-iron into the greenside bunker, but Knoll capped the victory in dramatic fashion on the difficult 18th (par 4, 434 yards) by splitting the fairway and knocking a 7-iron to 15 feet. When

the birdie putt fell into the cup, Knoll raised his right arm in victory.

Knoll would only say he was a little nervous standing on the final tee box. His top finish in an Amateur prior to this was an eighth-place showing at the CC of Scranton in 2003.

Rolfe, 45, of Wyncote, Pa., the reigning Huntingdon Valley CC club champion, refused to fold. Playing with Knoll and Walters in the final threesome, Rolfe did all he could for the gallery following him.

"The difference is they have fewer bad swings. And my bad swings were worse than theirs," said Rolfe, a real estate investor of competing against a younger crowd. "Every time I put a little heat on Alex he was up to the task."

Walters, 20, of Lancaster, Pa., is going to be a senior at Rollins College.

He tied for seventh last year in the Amateur at Fox Chapel GC.

Reigning Amateur Champion Blaine Peffley of Lebanon CC tied for 10th.

PLYMOUTH MEETING, Pa.— Sean Farren of Oakmont, Pa., blistered the back nine in 5-under-par 31, coming from four strokes back to win the 89th Open Championship by a shot at Sunnybrook GC (par 72, 6,886 yards). Farren finished at 12-under-par 204. Finishing in the next to last two some, Farren, 36, head profes-

sional at Totteridge GC in Greensburg, Pa., stood behind the 18th green as Kevin Shields of Bethel Park, Pa. nailed a 139-yard 9-iron out of a left fairway bunker to 3½ feet.

Shields, 33, an assistant pro at Mount Lebanon GC in Pittsburgh, needed the putt to tie Farren and force a playoff. He missed right on the slick, breaking putt.

Both golfers had trailed H. Robert McClellan, 25, of Butler, Pa., a professional at Olde Stonewall GC in

Ellwood City, Pa., for much of the last nine holes. McClellan had fired a 3-under-par 33 on the front nine to lead Shields by two shots and Farren by four at the turn.

But he lost the lead with two disastrous holes on Nos. 13 and 14. Starting on No. 13, a 421-yard par 4, he was 12 under after a birdie on the 559-yard par-4 10th hole. But he three-putted from 30 feet.

Then he hit a drive left against a boundary fence on the 439-yard par 4 14th, pitched out across the fairway under a tree, pitched back

across the fairway into thick rough and double-bogeyed the hole.

Shields also had his chances, tied for the lead at 12 under on the tee at the 203-yard par 3 17th. But he hit his tee shot long left into the rough, chipped six feet short and missed the putt for a bogey.

Meanwhile, Farren was tearing up the back nine with birdies on Nos. 10, 11, 13, 14, 16 and 17, with putts ranging from 15 feet to six inches. He lasered a 3-iron to six inches on No. 13 and a 4-iron to a foot on No. 17.

On No. 18 (409 yards, par 4), he hit his second shot short into the rough but chipped from 45 feet to 18 inches for the par that clinched the championship.

Farren said the key to his win was his iron play, as he sprayed several drives. "As long as I had an iron in my hands, I felt OK."

He said his first state championship was "really special."

"I looked at the championship trophy this morning, and I saw all those

awesome names on it, and its pretty special to have my name on it, too," said Farren.

Also special, he said, is that last year's champion, Ryan Sikora of Greensburg, Pa., is now his assistant at Totteridge GC.

Low amateur at 8-under-par 209 was Tyler Brewington, 19, of Orangeville, Pa., who plays to a plus-2.2 handicap out of Mill Race GC in Benton, Pa., and is a member of the Rider University golf team in Trenton, N.J.

He was one shot better than Roc Irey of Warrington, Pa, who shared a piece of the first-round lead after opening with a 5-under 67.

"I putted really, really well all week," Brewington said. "I thought for a while I had a real shot at the leaders. It was fun."

Is there professional golf in his future? "That's my long-term goal," he said. "I've got some big decisions to make."

The top 30 scores and ties for this year's Pennsylvania Open are exempt from next year's Open at Nemacolin Woodlands Resort in Farmington, Pa., site of the PGA Tour's 84 Lumber Classic.

Schlachter previously had won the Pennsylvania Amateur Championship in 1998 and the Senior Amateur Championship in 2004. For Schlachter, the Mid-Am was his fourth Pennsylvania title, having won the Senior Better-Ball Championship with fellow club member Bill Kunsman earlier in 2005.

He was also a semifinalist in the 2005 R. Jay Sigel Pennsylvania Amateur Match Play Championship at Stonewall.

Schlachter and Bohn had fired 6-under-par 138s to tie for the Mid-Amateur lead after 36 holes. Schlachter, at 1-over 73 on the first day, six shots back of the leader, roared back on the second round with eight birdies and a bogey for a 7-under-par 65. Bohn, playing steadily, carded 69-69.

"I had trouble in the wind and the rain the first day," Schlachter said, "but I hit it good and putted really good on Tuesday and started making birdies."

He was 8-under par heading to 18. But he thought he'd blown it on the par 4, 391-yard 18th, his 36th, where he hit his drive left into trees, punched out and bogeyed the hole.

"I thought I lost it. I thought Brownie would bring it home," he said. David, Brown, St. Clair CC, was the first-round leader with 67, but he struggled to a 72 in the final round for a 139, tying with John Donnelly, Concord CC (71-68) for third.

In the playoff, back on No. 18,

Schlachter, hit left into the trees again and had to punch out, but he got up and down from 50 yards, after a "terrific pitch," by nailing a 15-foot par putt to halve the hole and tie Bohn. "I did what I was doing all day," Schlachter said, "making putts."

Moving to No. 10, (par 4, 334 yards) for the second playoff hole, Schlachter was on the green in two strokes, while Bohn caught a greenside bunker, blasted out long and missed his par putt. Two putts from eight feet and Schlachter, who plays to a plus-3 handicap and tried qualifying for the Senior, now Champions, Tour when he turned 50, was the winner.

"This victory was very special because I was sick and couldn't play golf for eight weeks, so this feels especially good," he said. He had a serious infection in his back diagnosed in July and spent nine weeks on antibiotics, five of them administered intravenously. He dropped out of the State Senior Championship after four holes.

But now the former public school teacher, currently in the commercial real estate business, is healthy again and very much looking forward to next year. "It feels really good to be the holder of all three championships," he said, "and I'm really looking forward to playing in more championships next year."

1st Hemlock Championship

Bellewood Golf Club – North Coventry, Pa.
May 9-10, 2005

NORTH COVENTRY, Pa.—It wasn't easy, but Robin McCool of Saucon Valley CC did just enough to repel the competition and capture the first-ever Hemlock Championship at Bellewood GC (par 71, 6,609 yards).

The Hemlock, a new event named after the State tree, is a competition for players ages 45-54 years of age.

McCool entered the second and final round five shots in front of the field in search of his first Pennsylvania state championship. However, it was a challenging day with the putter for the 54-year-old and McCool watched his advantage dwindle to one shot on an early surge from Michael Domenick of Phoenixville CC and a late effort by Richard Thon of The Springhaven Club. In the end, McCool's second-round 77 equated to a 1-over-par finish for the tournament and placed him two strokes clear of the field.

Domenick and Thon tied for second at 4-over par.

"It feels great. It's a great accomplishment to win a state event at any level," said McCool of Bethlehem, Pa. "I'm ecstatic about that.

"I didn't play particularly well today, but that's golf. You have to deal with it."

McCool carded five bogeys on the front side as the field closed the gap. He three-putted for four of those. However, McCool, a tournament veteran, righted the ship with

birdies on Nos. 10 (par 5, 582 yards) and 13 (par 4, 335 yards) and closed his round out with a 1-over-par 36 on the back nine.

"I couldn't get into any rhythm on the greens," said McCool. "I had a lot of difficult putts that were going up and over and across ridges."

McCool knocked a gap wedge from 90 yards to three feet on No. 10 to get his groove back. On the treacherous 13th, he intentionally landed his pitching wedge short of the green and watched it roll to eight feet. He converted a tricky right to left breaker.

Thon, 50, of Swarthmore, Pa., and Domenick, 50, of Phoenixville, Pa., both had moments.

Thon recorded five birdies and five bogeys en route to an even-par

71. He was 1-under par at the turn and 2 under after 10 holes before three bogeys in the span of four holes eliminated him from the title hunt.

Domenick went out in 1-under 35, before a bogey, double-bogey start on the back, quieted his run.

"If I go home with a piece of glass [trophy], my wife will be surprised," stated Thon. "Starting the day I would have taken that. I didn't collapse. He won it."

McCool's top finish in a Pennsylvania state event prior to the Hemlock was a third-place showing in the 1998 Amateur at Bent Creek CC. The victory marks a comeback of sorts for McCool. Health issues have plagued him since 2001. That year he successfully battled testicular cancer. In 2003, McCool found himself on the sideline with a pinched nerve in his back and, in 2004, a staph infection shelved him for a period of time.

McCool is a former New Jersey State Golf Association Middle-Amateur champion and has also recorded victories in both Golf Association of Philadelphia and Arizona State Golf Association events.

He said that after winning the Amateur, his work kept him out of golf for awhile, “but I practiced for the Public Links and for the first time since I

55th Junior Championship

Jimmy Markovitz of The Club at Nevillewood said he was devastated after failing to hold the final-round lead at the Junior Championship a year ago. This summer the 18-year-old made sure history didn't repeat itself.

Markovitz finished at 4-under par (66-72—138) on Penn National GC's pair of courses (Founder's/Iron Forge), good enough for a two-stroke victory in the 55th Junior Championship and his first state title. Benjamin Fellman of Golden Oaks GC and John Popeck of The Club at Nevillewood tied for second.

"I was really looking forward to [the final round] this year. I just felt more prepared for the situation," said the Bridgeville, Pa., native. "And I definitely drew upon last year's experience."

In 2004, Markovitz held a two-shot lead after Round 1 but struggled on the front side in the final round and lost by a stroke. A couple of poor swings wiped out his chance at victory.

This year, Markovitz, who's headed to Ohio State University in the fall, opened his last 18 holes with a four-stroke cushion after opening with a 66. Two bogeys in the first four holes of Round 2 erased some of that edge, however, but Markovitz found his game and registered two birdies and 12 pars in his final 14 holes to salt away a win.

"I only missed two greens the entire week," said Markovitz. "And I made my share of 10 footers."

Markovitz opened the Junior Championship with seven birdies and a bogey en route to an opening-round 66. His lone bogey, a 3-putt on No. 9, his 18th hole.

In the second round, he was even par and a couple shots to the good standing on the difficult 16th (par 3, 195 yards).

"I had a long wait on the tee box, 20 to 25 minutes, and the wind was 10-15 mph," said Markovitz. "I hit a solid 4-iron and made par and got out of there."

Markovitz is a senior South Fayette High School.

"I felt like this was a tournament I could go out and win if I played well," said Markovitz. "I was just fortunate my game was clicking."

Markovitz finished in a tie for 17th in the 2002 Junior Boys' Championship before his second-place

effort last year.

Both players hit their drives into pine trees on the right. Both punched out. Knox cut a high 4-iron around another stand of pines to five feet to birdie the hole. Burton caught a bunker and three-putted for a double bogey. It was a three-shot swing.

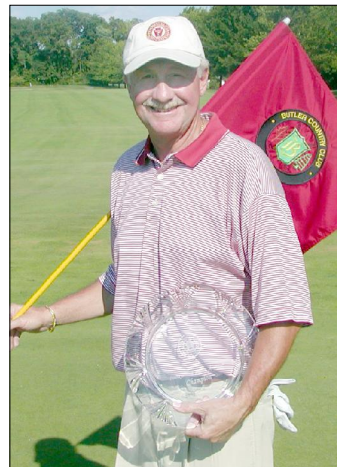
Burton also doubled the par 3 17th

“I got a bad bounce on the tee shot on No. 17 and then a bad lie on the second shot that went into the greenside bunker up against the lip,” said Burton. “The 17th hole ended up being a reflection of the bad feelings from 16.”

For Knox, 62, a scratch handicapper and a member of the Pennsylvania Golf Association Executive Committee, it was his first state championship. “It’s a real honor, a humbling experience, but a great experience” he said. “As a member of the Executive Committee it makes me feel really good. But I joined the committee to give back to the

In that round, Brookreson recorded birdies on Nos. 3 (par 5, 480 yards); 8 (par 4, 379 yards); 11 (par 3, 138 yards); 14 (par 5, 485 yards) and 15 (par 3, 168 yards) and bogeys on Nos. 4 (par 4, 380 yards); 6 (par 5, 530 yards) and 12 (par 4, 361 yards).

"The neat part of the tournament for me was that the golf courses are totally different," said Brookreson. "The Wissahickon is an old traditional course and the Militia Hill is a more modern course. Obviously, it's nice to know I can handle both. I tried to keep the ball in the middle of the fairway, get on the greens and don't make many mistakes."

Sean Knapp, Chris Lange and Nathan Smith guided the Pennsylvania Golf Association to its best-ever finish in the U.S. Men's State Team Championship. The trio finished in sixth place with a 430 total (2 under), eight shots behind champion Texas, at the Berkeley Hall Club in Bluffton, S.C.

Pennsylvania's top showing prior to 2005 was a tie for 10th place in 1999 at the Golden Horseshoe Golf Club in Williamsburg, Va.

Lange shot a 77-75-70, Knapp posted scores of 71-75-74 and Smith carded rounds of 68-72-74. Team scores for the U.S. State Team were calculated by taking the low two scores of three for each round.

Every state golf association plus the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico fielded teams (52 total).

"I knew we had a good chance to be competitive because Nathan and Sean are such strong players," said Lange, who qualified for three USGA Championships this year. "Down the stretch, however, we didn't play as well as we could have."

The USGA Men's State Team Championship grew out of the Association's Centennial Celebration in 1995. Each state is represented by non-college, amateur golfers and the event is held every two years.

Alex Knoll – Bethlehem Golf Club

Alex Knoll's crazy "dream" came true. Knoll, of Bethlehem Golf Club, mentioned to his regular caddie John Gilbert prior to the start of an U.S. Amateur Qualifier in late July that even though time was running out he could still make a push for the William C. Fownes, Jr., Player of the Year. The Davidson University junior figured he needed to qualify for the U.S. Amateur and probably win the Pennsylvania Amateur Championship to do so. A long shot, but possible.

A week later, Knoll found himself posing for photos with the Pennsylvania Golf Association Championship Trophy, emblematic of the Amateur winner. That came only days removed from qualifying for his first U.S. Amateur Championship. That surge helped Knoll to 608 points, 163 points clear of second-place finisher Dan Walters. In addition to the Amateur victory, Knoll earned impressive points by surviving a grueling playoff to advance into match play of the U.S. Amateur at Merion GC; was part of the state Better-Ball Championship winning team with Christian Davis; qualified for the

U.S. Public Links Championship and placed third in the Pennsylvania Amateur Public Links.

"I had a wild dream that if I qualified for the U.S. Amateur and won the [state] Amateur I could win Player of the Year," said Knoll, 20, of Bethlehem, Pa., "and that actually happened."

Knoll's rise started with a third-place tie in the Dressler Amateur Public Links. He then advanced to the U.S. Publinks but missed qualifying for match play by a stroke. On the first day of June, Knoll teamed with college teammate Christian Davis of Glenmaura National GC to take the Better-Ball Championship at White Manor CC by birdieing the first playoff hole.

Knoll then qualified for the U.S. Amateur at Battleground CC in Tennent, N.J. with a 138 total in mid-July.

A week later, he led from start to **finish to take the 93^d** Pennsylvania Amateur Championship at Huntingdon Valley CC. Knoll recorded the only under-par score (2 under) for the tournament's 54 holes.

Knoll topped the year with a fantastic three days at the U.S. Amateur

in mid-August. He finished at 6-over-par 146 and found himself in a 19 player for 17 qualifying positions playoff. A par on the first extra hole kept his hopes of advancing alive. He then lasered a 3-iron to four feet on the second playoff hole (No. 14, par 4, 438 yards) for a birdie and a spot in the match play field. Knoll fell to eventual finalist Dillon Dougherty of Woodland, Calif., 5&3, in the first round.
