#### **NOTICE TO PLAYERS**

**THE RULES OF THE UNITED STATES GOLF ASSOCIATION GOVERN PLAY:** Complete text of Rules and Local Rules may be found in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf, effective January 2019. This information also supplements the 2020 PAGA Local Rules (Hard Card) and the PAGA Covid-19 Procedures.

**FORMAT:** 54-holes of Stroke Play. Three 18-hole stipulated rounds. Cut to low 40 and ties for third round. All play is from the **RED PAGA Tee Marks.** 

**AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION:** Single rider carts are permitted. Caddies are permitted.

**SCORECARDS:** Physical scorecards will not be issued and groups will be given a GGID for scoring on the Golf Genius app on the starting tee. Players should verify their scores at the scoring area at the completion of their round.

#### SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** Defined by inside points at ground level of white stakes, white line and boundary fences.

\*A ball which crosses a public road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the course.

**ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS:** Enclosed white-lined areas are defined as ground under repair, see Rule 16. French drains are deemed to be ground under repair.

\*All flowerbeds are ground under repair, relief is mandatory.

**BUNKERS:** For a ball that lies in a bunker, the player may lift, clean and place – 1 club length no closer to the hole or play the ball as it lies. If lifted, the ball must remain in the bunker. Players may NOT improve the sand in the area of intended placement. Players should smooth their damage in a bunker as much as possible after play from a bunker. Bunker rakes may be removed from the course.

**IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:** Stone cart paths are immovable obstructions and relief may be taken. Wood chipped and GUR areas leading into cart paths will have the same status as the path, that of obstructions.

**PRACTICE GROUND:** The practice putting green, short game area and driving range are a part of the competition course on which players may practice.

**PENALTY AREAS:** When marked with stakes and lines, stakes identify and lines define the penalty area. Artificial walls and pilings located in penalty areas are integral parts of golf course.

\*Dropping Zone for Penalty Areas on Hole #2, Hole #4, Hole #7 and Hole #18 - If a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found last crossed the margin of a Penalty Area (yellow stakes and lines), the player may: 1) proceed under Rule 17; or 2) as an additional option, drop a ball, under penalty of one stoke, in the dropping zone (labeled DZ).

**PLAY-OFF:** In the event of a tie for the 107th Amateur championship, a sudden-death playoff will begin immediately following the conclusion of play.

**PACE OF PLAY:** 2-Point checkpoint policy in effect. Time allowed to complete stipulated round at Lookaway Golf Club is **3 Hours and 45 Minutes.** Checkpoints will be on holes 9 and 18.
