NOTICE TO PLAYERS

THE RULES OF THE UNITED STATES GOLF ASSOCIATION GOVERN PLAY: Complete text of Rules and Local Rules may be found in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf, effective January 2019. This information also supplements the 2020 PAGA Local Rules (Hard Card) and the PAGA Covid-19 Procedures.

FORMAT: 18-Holes Individual Stroke Play. The top four (4) scores and ties will advance to the 104th Open Championship. All play is from the **White PAGA Tee Marks.**

AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION: Single rider carts are permitted for the stipulated round and included with entry fee. Caddies are Not permitted.

SCORECARDS: Physical scorecards will not be issued and groups will be given a GGID for scoring on the Golf Genius app on the starting tee. Players should verify their scores at the scoring area at the completion of their round.

SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

OUT OF BOUNDS: Defined by white stakes, boundary fences and the interior edge of all public roads. See Rule 18. *The parking lot is out of bounds.

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS: Enclosed white-lined areas are defined as ground under repair, see Rule 16. French drains are deemed to be ground under repair. *All flowerbeds are considered ground under repair and NO PLAY ZONES, relief is mandatory.

PRACTICE GROUND: The driving range, practice hole and the practice putting green are parts of the competition course on which players may practice.

BUNKERS: For a ball that lies in a bunker, the player may lift, clean and place – 1 club length no closer to the hole or play the ball as it lies. If lifted, the ball must remain in the bunker. Players may NOT improve the sand in the area of intended placement. Players should smooth their damage in a bunker as much as possible after play from a bunker. Bunker rakes may be removed from the course.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS: Paved and stone cart paths are immovable obstructions and relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 24-2b. Wood chipped and GUR areas leading into cart paths will have the same status as the path, that of obstructions.

PENALTY AREAS: Artificial walls and pilings located in penalty areas are integral parts of golf course.

PACE OF PLAY: 2-Point checkpoint policy in effect. Time allowed to complete stipulated round at Elmhurst Country Club is **4 Hours and 5 Minutes.** Checkpoints will be on holes 9 and 18.




