NOTICE TO PLAYERS

THE RULES OF THE UNITED STATES GOLF ASSOCIATION GOVERN PLAY: Complete text of Rules and Local Rules may be found in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf, effective January 2019. This information also supplements the 2020 PAGA Local Rules (Hard Card) and the PAGA Covid-19 Procedures.

FORMAT: 36-hole stroke play championship. Two 18-hole stipulated rounds. In the event of inclement weather, the championship will not continue past the last scheduled day and may be reduced to an 18-hole event. All play will be from the **White PAGA Tee Markers**.

CADDIES: Caddies are Not permitted.

SCORECARDS: Physical scorecards will not be issued and groups will be given a GGID for scoring on the Golf Genius app on the starting tee. Players should verify their scores at the scoring area at the completion of their round. 1st day score will determine 2nd day starting times.

PLAYOFF: In the event of a tie for the Championship, players will compete in sudden death playoff, beginning on #18, then #16, then #17, and repeating.

PLAYERS LUNCH: A boxed lunch will be provided (included in entry fee) for all players from 11-3 p.m.

SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

OUT OF BOUNDS: Out of Bounds is defined by the inside edge at ground level of white lines, white stakes, metal guard rails, split rail fences and public roadways.

*A ball which crosses a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the course.

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS: Enclosed white-lined areas are defined as ground under repair, see Rule 16.

*Flowerbeds (mulched and prepared) are considered No Play Zones and relief is Mandatory.

BUNKERS: For a ball that lies in a bunker, the player may lift, clean and place – 1 club length no closer to the hole or play the ball as it lies. If lifted, the ball must remain in the bunker. Players may NOT improve the sand in the area of intended placement. Players should smooth their damage in a bunker as much as possible after play from a bunker. Bunker rakes may be removed from the course.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS: Paved, stone and dirt cart paths are immovable obstructions and relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 16.1a. Wood chipped and GUR areas leading into cart paths will have the same status as the path, that of obstructions.

PENALTY AREAS: Artificial walls and pilings located in penalty areas are integral parts of the golf course.

*As an additional option for a ball that comes to rest in the right penalty area on #16, players may proceed to the drop zone.

PACE OF PLAY: 2-Point checkpoint policy in effect. Time allowed to complete stipulated round at Hershey Country Club is **4 Hours and 24 Minutes.** Checkpoints will be on holes 9 and 18.






